SUFFOLK FIRE & RESCUE RESPOND TO RESIDENTIAL STRUCTURE FIRE

SUFFOLK, Virginia (November 16, 2014) Suffolk Fire & Rescue personnel responded to a residential structure fire in the 2800 block of North Shore Drive this afternoon. Emergency Dispatchers were notified of the fire at 12:48 p.m. and the first unit arrived on the scene at 12:54 p.m.

The first responders found a single story residential structure with smoke showing on the front of the structure. After further investigation, they found that a baseboard heater had shorted out and set the living room wall on fire. The fire was contained to the living room. The fire was marked under control at 1:05 p.m.

The two occupants (one adult and one child) will be displaced as a result of the fire. There were no injuries.

Engine 5, Engine 10, Engine 25, Medic 10A, Battalion 2, Ladder 5, and EMS 1 responded to the scene.
