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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (May 28, 2013) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Tuesday, May 28, 2013, due to construction and maintenance projects:

New Projects:

(Pruden Boulevard & North Main Street) – A contractor will have a lane closure in the right eastbound lane on Prudent Boulevard and North Main Street between Stuart Avenue and Murphy's Mill Road for the installation of a sewer force main Tuesday, May 28 through Friday, May 31. The lane closure will be in place from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. daily.

(Dutch Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Dutch Road between Quaker Drive and Longstreet Lane until 3 p.m.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have a closure on the left southbound shoulder on Bridge Road from the Mills Godwin Bridge to Isle of Wight County until 4 p.m.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Division of Public Works Traffic Engineering Paint Crew will have a mobile lane closure on Route 58 between Kenyon Road and Holland Road from 8 p.m. on Tuesday, May 28 through 5 a.m. on Wednesday, May 29.

Ongoing Projects:

(Pioneer Road) – A contractor will have lane closures on Pioneer Road near the intersection with Holland Road/Route 58 at various times throughout the week.

(Route 10/Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a southbound shoulder closure on Route 10/Godwin Boulevard between the Reids Ferry Bridge and 1000 feet north of the pump station. They will also have a lane closure in the northbound lane from Sack Point Road to Harrell Drive from 7 a.m. to 3 p.m. This pipe installation project will continue for the next three to five months. The contractor will also have a lane closure in the outside northbound lane on Godwin Boulevard 1000 feet before the two lanes of traffic merge to one. This closure will be in effect day and night for the next 3 weeks while large sections of pipe are being installed.

(Shoulders Hill Road and Nansemond Parkway intersection) - A contractor continues with ongoing work at the intersection of Shoulders Hill Road and Nansemond Parkway.

(Market Street & Henley Place) – Thru traffic on Market Street and Henley Place will be restricted until June 28, 2013, to facilitate additional pavement and concrete work for the City of Suffolk E-911/Municipal Center project. The west entrance to the Main Municipal Center Parking Lot will be closed. All public and staff traffic to the Human Resources Building will utilize the same entrance and travel along the north side of the parking lot to the building. Access to the Human Resources Building can also happen via Washington Street to Pender Street on the west side of the Police Administration Building.

(Village of Holland) – A contractor will have periodic flagging operations in place on Ruritan Boulevard, South Quay Road, and Holland Road Business and side streets within the Holland Village area, Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., installing new water mains. The expected completion date is September 2013.

(Pruden Boulevard & Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have the right eastbound lane on Pruden Boulevard closed from the 2500 block of Pruden Boulevard to Meade Parkway until 3 p.m. This closure will be in effect periodically until October 2013 while a new pump station is constructed.

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
