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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (November 1, 2016) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Tuesday, November 1, 2016, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a shoulder closure on the Godwin Boulevard on-ramp from westbound Route 58 and a westbound lane closure on the overpass on Godwin Boulevard from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have the outside westbound lane closed for paving and milling on Route 58 between Brentwood Road and OKelly Drive from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., October 31st through November 2nd.

(Various Locations) – A contractor will have a mobile operation at the following locations: Route 13/32 Bypass and Holland Road for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

(Bute Street) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Bute Street at West Washington Street from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Carolina Road) – A contractor will have a southbound outside lane closure in the 1100 block of Carolina Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Holland Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation eastbound in the 3200 block of Holland Road for ditch maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Nansemond Parkway) – Suffolk Department of Public Utilities Line Maintenance will have a lane closure at the 1100 to 1200 blocks of Nansemond Parkway for utility work. Traffic control will be setup from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. with flaggers.

(Badger Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Badger Road between White Marsh Road and Hosier Road for ditch maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(St. James Avenue) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on St. James Avenue from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Godwin Boulevard) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation westbound on Godwin Boulevard between Willow Lane and Kings Highway for a sidewalk install from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(West Riverview Drive) – A contractor has West Riverview Drive closed between Butler Avenue and North Broad Street for road and washout repair. This closure is expected to remain until Friday evening.

(North Main Street) – A contractor will have a southbound outside lane closure on North Main Street between the 7-Eleven and Northgate Lane and an outside left turn lane closure on Godwin Boulevard at North Main Street. This closure will be 24 hours a day for up to two weeks.

Upcoming Projects:

(Badger Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Badger Road closed between White Marsh Road and the 2900 block for bridge repair.

Ongoing Projects:

(Arthur Drive) – A contractor will be reconstructing bridges over Spivey Run and Langston Swamp on Arthur Drive. A detour will be in place to direct motorists with the detour in place. This closure is expected to be complete by December 30, 2016.

(Highland Avenue) – A contractor will be installing a new pump station and sewer and water lines on Highland Avenue between Kingsboro Street and the end of Highland Avenue at the cul-de-sac. This project will continue through June 2017.

(Seaboard Trail) – A contractor will have the Seaboard Trail from Main Street to Moore Avenue closed to all pedestrians until further notice. The contractor is estimating a December completion date.

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
