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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (November 3, 2015) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Tuesday, November 3, 2015 due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Carolina Road) – A contractor will have a right lane closure on Carolina Road northbound between Coleman Court and Benton Road from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(East Pinner Street) – A contractor will have East Pinner Street closed between Newport Street and Moore Avenue Tuesday, November 3rd and Wednesday, November 4th from 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. A detour will be in place and accommodations will be made for school buses, emergency and other city vehicles. Delays should be expected in this area.

(Market Street) – Public Works Traffic Engineering’s paint crew will have a work zone on Market Street between Saratoga Street and North Street from 8:30 a.m. to 2 p.m.

(Shoulders Hill Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Shoulders Hill Road northbound between Nansemond Parkway and Pughsville Road for a milling/paving operation from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Tuesday, November 3rd thru Friday, November 6th. Delays should be expected along this route.

Ongoing Projects:

(Katherine Street) – A contractor will have Katherine Street closed between East Pinner Street and East Constance Road from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. All traffic will be detoured to surrounding streets. Accommodations will be made for residents and emergency vehicles. Work will continue until further notice.

(Prentis Street) – A contractor will have Prentis Street closed to thru traffic between Constance Avenue and Pine Street. Traffic will be detoured to surrounding streets. City, Emergency and Resident access will be accommodated. The closure will be in effect for 24 hours a day until further notice.

(Seaboard Trail) – A contractor will have the Seaboard Trail from Main Street to Moore Avenue closed to all pedestrians until further notice.

(Turlington Park Neighborhood) – A contractor will be working on the installation of the sewer mains for the Turlington Park Neighborhood. The work hours will be 7 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday thru Friday. Anticipate detoured traffic in the neighborhood as the sewer mains are being constructed. The project scheduled completion date is November 30, 2015.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor is working in the right-of-way along the east side of Godwin Boulevard between Harrell Drive and the Virginia Dominion Power facility

right-of-way along Pembroke Lane and at Kings Highway in the vicinity of the Chuckatuck Fire Department. Flagging operations may be required.

(Church Street) – A contractor will have Church Street closed between Dumville Lane and Mahan Street from 7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. All traffic will be detoured to surrounding streets. Accommodations will be made for residents and emergency vehicles. Work will continue until further notice.

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
