(Spruce Street) – A contractor will be milling on Spruce Street from 12 p.m. to 3 p.m.

ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (November 17, 2015) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Tuesday, November 17, 2015 due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Liberty Street) – Norfolk Southern will be working on crossing upgrades on Liberty Street between Bank Street and East Washington Street requiring the complete shutdown of the road at the affected crossing and detours will be posted. Liberty Street will be closed beginning the morning of November 16 and is expected to reopen on the evening of November 19.

(Shoulders Hill Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on northbound Shoulders Hill Road for a paving operation from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Suffolk Police will be at the intersection of Shoulders Hill Road and Pughsville Road directing traffic.

(Carolina Road) – A contractor will have a right lane closure on Carolina Road between Coleman Court and Benton Road from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(East Washington Street) – Dominion Power will have the 100 block of East Washington Street closed from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. with a detour in place.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on eastbound and westbound Route 58 between Business 58 and the Southampton County Line for asphalt repair from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Mineral Spring Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Mineral Spring Road between Longstreet Lane and Whaleyville Boulevard for asphalt repair from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Suburban Drive) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Suburban Drive for asphalt repair from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Kings Highway and Bennetts Pasture Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering Paint Crew will have a work zone at the intersection of Kings Highway and Bennetts Pasture Road from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.

(Kings Highway) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Kings Highway for shoulder maintenance from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(North Main Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Utilities Line Maintenance will have a lane closure in the 100 block of North Main Street. Traffic control will be in place from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(North Main Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Utilities Line Maintenance will have a lane closure in the 1500 block of southbound North Main Street. Traffic control will be in place from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.

Ongoing Projects:

(Katherine Street) – A contractor will have Katherine Street closed between East Pinner Street and East Constance Road from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. All traffic will be detoured to surrounding streets. Accommodations will be made for residents and emergency vehicles. Work will continue until further notice.

(Prentis Street) – A contractor will have Prentis Street closed to thru traffic between Constance Avenue and Pine Street. Traffic will be detoured to surrounding streets. City, Emergency and Resident access will be accommodated. The closure will be in effect for 24 hours a day until further notice.

(Church Street) – A contractor will have Church Street closed between Dumville Lane and Mahan Street from 7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. All traffic will be detoured to surrounding streets. Accommodations will be made for residents and emergency vehicles. Work will continue until further notice.

(Seaboard Trail) – A contractor will have the Seaboard Trail from Main Street to Moore Avenue closed to all pedestrians until further notice.

(Turlington Park Neighborhood) – A contractor will be working on the installation of the sewer mains for the Turlington Park Neighborhood. The work hours will be 7 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday thru Friday. Anticipate detoured traffic in the neighborhood as the sewer mains are being constructed. The project scheduled completion date is November 30, 2015.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor is working in the right-of-way along the east side of Godwin Boulevard between Harrell Drive and the Virginia Dominion Power facility right-of-way along Pembroke Lane and at Kings Highway in the vicinity of the Chuckatuck Fire Department. The work is scheduled to be completed by November 20, 2015.

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
