Grand Opening of New Adult Day Support Center

SUFFOLK, Virginia (November 19, 2013) – On Wednesday, November 20th, at 10 a.m., Candie’s Place Adult Day Support will host a Ribbon Cutting and Grand Opening ceremony at 1931 Holland Road. Council Member Jeffrey Gardy will be on hand for this event, which is open to the public.

Candie’s Place Adult Day Support provides Day Support services to individuals eighteen and older that are intellectually disabled, as well as additionally with a secondary diagnosis.

The clients can be dropped off at the support center and picked up anytime between 8 a.m. and 3 p.m. The individuals will enjoy a game room, a sensory room, music, socializing and regular van trips throughout the community. The staff there provides skilled nursing services and medication assistance.

Jackie Myrick, Co-Owner, wanted to provide an inviting location for senior citizens and disabled people to be able to interact and thrive. “We want Candie’s Place to feel like a home-away-from-home,” Myrick remarked. “Participants and their loved ones should feel special and safe there.”

Candie's Place has a capacity for around 35 daily participants. They are part of the Noble Care LLC community-based group homes family. There are currently two Noble Care group homes in Suffolk.

"The health and welfare of our senior population is important to our community," said Suffolk Mayor Linda T. Jonson. "We are pleased to have Candie's Place Adult Day Support provide a unique and important service in Suffolk."
