SUFFOLK FIRE & RESCUE RESPOND TO RESIDENTIAL STRUCTURE FIRE

SUFFOLK, Virginia (December 15, 2014) Suffolk Fire & Rescue personnel responded to a residential structure fire in the 800 Block of Cripple Creek Lane this afternoon. Emergency Dispatchers were notified of the fire at 2:38 p.m. and the first unit arrived on the scene at 2:44 p.m.

The first responders arrived to find a two story residential structure with light smoke showing. Fire & Rescue personnel attacked a small kitchen fire which was marked under control at approximately 2:55 p.m. There were no injuries to the occupants or fire crews on the scene. The family of two adults and three children are displaced and the American Red Cross will be providing assistance.

The cause of the fire was unattended cooking with the fire causing approximately \$75,000 worth of damage.

Engine 3, Ladder 3, Engine 2, Rescue 1, Battalion 1, EMS 1, Medic 3, and Fire Marshal 1 responded to the scene. Suffolk Police assisted with traffic control.
