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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (November 25, 2014) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Tuesday, November 25, 2014, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Sleepy Hole Road) – A contractor will have a lane closure on Sleepy Hole Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Deer Path Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Deer Path Road near Indian Trail from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Route 58 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(various locations) – A contractor will have a lane closure at the following locations: Constance Road and North Main Street, Pinner Street and Catherine Street, Washington Street and Bute Street, and Fayette Avenue and Carolina Road. Each closure will last about an hour and all work should be done between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m.

(Godwin Boulevard) – Suffolk Department of Public Utilities Line Maintenance will have a lane closure in the 2300 block of Godwin Boulevard from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.

(Whaleyville Boulevard) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Whaleyville Boulevard between Carolina Road and the North Carolina state line from 8 a.m. to 11 a.m.

(Carolina Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Carolina Road between Whaleyville Boulevard and the North Carolina state line from 8 a.m. to 11 a.m.

Ongoing Projects:

(Turlington Road) – The Turlington Road Sewer Extension Project is planned to run through April 2015, 7 a.m. and 4 p.m., Monday through Friday. The work will require the closure of Turlington Road to thru traffic between Jackson Road and Old Somerton Road. Access for local traffic including the Turlington Woods Alternative School and emergency vehicles will be provided.

(Turlington Road and Lake Speight Colony Neighborhood) – A contractor is working within the Lake Speight Colony Neighborhood as part of the sewer improvements for this neighborhood. Work is being conducted along Turlington Road and on Austin Drive. Anticipate detoured traffic on Austin Drive as the gravity sewer is being constructed. This work should be completed by December 1, 2014.

(Robbie Road) – The Suffolk Department of Public Works and a contractor will begin working on the bridge along Robbie Road, beginning on August 28, 2014. The project will require the closure of the roadway at the bridge site with work expected to be completed by December 10, 2014. A detour will be in place to route thru traffic.

(Manning Bridge Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Operations and a contractor will work on the bridge along Manning Bridge Road beginning Monday, July 28, 2014. The project will require the closure of the roadway at the bridge site and work is expected to be completed by December 5, 2014. A detour will be in place to route thru traffic.

(Various locations) – A contractor will be working on the installation of water and sewer mains for the Crittenden/Eclipse water and sewer extension project. The work hours will be from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday through Friday. The project will be ongoing until spring 2015. Flagging operations will be necessary on the following streets: Wigneil Street, Vine Street, Pike Street, Rivershore Drive, Dixon Road, Cross Street, Eclipse Drive, Bleakhorn Drive, and Darden Clubhouse Road during the period of construction

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
