### **SUFFOLK FIRE & RESCUE AND SUFFOLK POLICE RESPOND TO TWO VEHICLE ACCIDENT**

SUFFOLK, Virginia (January 20, 2015) Suffolk Fire & Rescue and Suffolk Police responded to the scene of a two vehicle accident on eastbound Route 58 near the Route 460/Pruden Boulevard exit this evening. Emergency Dispatch was notified of the accident at 5:34 p.m.

One vehicle reportedly ran into the back of a tow truck that was at this location handling a previous accident. The male driver of the vehicle suffered serious injuries and was airlifted via Nightingale to Sentara Norfolk General Hospital following medical assessment and treatment by Suffolk Fire & Rescue personnel. There were no other injuries reported as a result of the accident.

Both lanes of eastbound Route 58 are closed at this location with traffic being diverted to Route 460/Pruden Boulevard via the exit ramp. The roadway will be closed for an undetermined amount of time.

The accident remains under investigation.
