FIREFIGHTERS RESPOND TO RESIDENTIAL STRUCTURE FIRE

SUFFOLK, VA (February 23, 2015) Suffolk Fire & Rescue responded earlier this afternoon to a residential structure fire in the 3100 block of Deer Path Road in rural Suffolk.

Emergency Communications received the call at 3:14 p.m. and the first units arrived at 3:25 p.m. Upon arrival firefighters found a one-story shed fully involved, with the fire then extending into the attached one-story residence. The fire was called under control at 4:10 p.m. There were no injuries.

One adult was displaced as a result of the fire and is being assisted by family.

Battalion 1, Engines 1, 2 and 4, Rescue 1, Medic 1, Rehab 6, EMS 1, Ladder 3, Car 3 and Tanker 1 responded to the scene, as well as Tanker 7 from the Holland Volunteer Fire Department.

Suffolk Police provided traffic control and security and the roadway was briefly closed.

The Fire Marshal's office is investigating.
