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### **ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS**

SUFFOLK, VA (October 12, 2016) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Wednesday, October 12, 2016, due to construction and maintenance projects.

#### **New Projects:**

(Charlotte Avenue) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Charlotte Avenue closed at Laurel Street and Lewis Avenue from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a shoulder closure on the Godwin Boulevard on-ramp from Route 58 westbound from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(North Main Street) – A contractor will have mobile lane closures on North Main Street between the Walmart entrance and Constance Road then moving to the 1000 block of Washington Street overnight beginning at 7:30 a.m. for overhead sign inspections.

(Wilroy Road) – A contractor will have alternating lane closures on Wilroy Road between Progress Road and Turner Road for a milling and paving operation from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. This work will include the Route 58 eastbound and westbound on ramps and the Route 58 westbound exit ramp. A variable message board has been placed to alert citizens.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a mobile operation eastbound and westbound on Route 58 between the Route 13/32 Bypass and the Chesapeake City line for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

(College Drive) – A contractor will have mobile lane closures on College Drive between Bridge Road and Hampton Roads Parkway from 11:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Bennetts Pasture Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering Paint Crew will have mobile lane closures on Bennetts Pasture Road between Pintail Drive and Ames Cove Drive from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Crittenden Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering Paint Crew will have mobile lane closures on Crittenden Road between Kings Highway and Bridge Road from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Turlington Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have an eastbound lane closure on Turlington Road between Jackson Road and Whaleyville Boulevard from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Manning Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a lane closure in the 1500 block of Manning Road for asphalt repair from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(White Marsh Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a lane closure in the 1100 block of White Marsh Road from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Burbage Drive) – A contractor will have a lane closure on Burbage Drive just before the intersection of McLauren Drive from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Prentis Street) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Prentis Street between Main Street and Pine Street for marking from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Pitchkettle Road) – A contractor will have alternating northbound and southbound single lane closures in the 1200 block of Pitchkettle Road for milling and paving operations. On and off ramps for eastbound Route 58 will have periodic and short term flagging operations at Pitchkettle Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Prentis Street) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Prentis Street between Main Street and Pine Street for marking from 12 p.m. to 4 p.m. on October 12th.

**Upcoming Projects:**

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a right lane closure eastbound and westbound on Route 58 at the scales for paving from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

**Ongoing Projects:**

(Arthur Drive) – A contractor will be reconstructing bridges over Spivey Run and Langston Swamp on Arthur Drive. A detour will be in place to direct motorists with the detour in place. This closure is expected to be complete by December 30, 2016.

(Highland Avenue) – A contractor will be installing a new pump station and sewer and water lines on Highland Avenue between Kingsboro Street and the end of Highland Avenue at the cul-de-sac. This project will continue through June 2017.

(Seaboard Trail) – A contractor will have the Seaboard Trail from Main Street to Moore Avenue closed to all pedestrians until further notice. The contractor is estimating a December completion date.

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
