(Pine Street) -- Pine Street between Market Street and Finney Avenue will remain closed until Friday, October 28th at 4 p.m.

ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (October 21, 2016) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Friday, October 21, 2016, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Charlotte Avenue) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Charlotte Avenue closed at Laurel Street and Lewis Avenue from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a shoulder closure on the Godwin Boulevard on-ramp from westbound Route 58 and a westbound lane closure on the overpass on Godwin Boulevard from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Various Locations) – A contractor will have mobile lane closures overnight from 7:30 p.m. to 3 a.m. for overhead sign inspections at the following locations: Main and Prentis, Constance and Prentis, Main and Suffolk Plaza Center (1000 Block), Fire Station #1 at 400 Market, and Main and Washington.

(Old Mill Road) – Old Mill Road will remain closed between Old Myrtle Road and Indian Trail Road until further notice due to a washout at the bridge in the 3700 to 3900 block.

(Pine Street) – A contractor will have Pine Street closed between Market Street and Finney Avenue from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., October 18th through October 21st. Accommodations will be made for residents and emergency vehicles.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have alternating lane closures, eastbound and westbound, on Route 58 between Brentwood Road and OKelly Drive for a milling and paving operation on Friday from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. and Saturday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Hosier Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging on Hosier Road for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Holland Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation eastbound in the 3000 block of Holland Road for ditch maintenance from 12 p.m. to 3 p.m.

(Holland Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a westbound outside lane closure in the 1200 block of Holland Road for drainage maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a mobile operation eastbound on Route 58 between Route 10 and the Chesapeake City line for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

(Wilroy Road) – A contractor will have mobile lane closures on Wilroy Road between Turner Drive and Progress Road from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(College Drive) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering Paint Crew will have mobile lane closures on College Drive between Hampton Roads Parkway and Bridge Road from 8:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.

(Wyanoke Trail) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Wyanoke Trail for pothole patching and shoulder maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Cherry Grove Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Cherry Grove Road for shoulder maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Main Street) – A contractor will have a lane closure on Main Street between VDOT and Murphys Mill Road from 6 a.m. to 4 p.m. The contractor will have the outside lane southbound and the outside lane northbound between the above mentioned areas of Main Street closed for roadway improvements, October 17th through October 21st.

Upcoming Projects:

(Main Street) – A contractor will have a lane closure on Main Street between VDOT and Murphys Mill Road from 6 a.m. to 4 p.m. The contractor will have the outside lane southbound and the outside lane northbound between the above mentioned areas of Main Street closed for roadway improvements, October 24th through October 28th.

Ongoing Projects:

(Arthur Drive) – A contractor will be reconstructing bridges over Spivey Run and Langston Swamp on Arthur Drive. A detour will be in place to direct motorists with the detour in place. This closure is expected to be complete by December 30, 2016.

(Highland Avenue) – A contractor will be installing a new pump station and sewer and water lines on Highland Avenue between Kingsboro Street and the end of Highland Avenue at the cul-de-sac. This project will continue through June 2017.

(Seaboard Trail) – A contractor will have the Seaboard Trail from Main Street to Moore Avenue closed to all pedestrians until further notice. The contractor is estimating a December completion date.

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
