**POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAY – SUPER LOAD MOVE**

SUFFOLK, VA (October 27, 2016) A super load move, involving a mobile home, could cause delays in traffic around 10 a.m., Monday, October 31, 2016.

The truck will begin the journey in the 1100 block of Nansemond Parkway and will travel on Nansemond Parkway, to Progress Road, to Wilroy Road, to the Route 13/58/460 Suffolk Bypass, to the Route 13/32 Bypass, to southbound Route 13 and will end in North Carolina.

The truck and load will measure 13 feet 6 inches tall, 16 feet wide, 102 feet long, and weigh 54,000 pounds.

The move will have certified front and rear escorts as well as Suffolk Police escorts.
