ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (September 11, 2012) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Tuesday, September 11, 2012, due to construction and maintenance projects:

New Projects:

(Nansemond Parkway) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Nansemond Parkway between Portsmouth Boulevard and Progress Road until 3:30 p.m. for ditch maintenance.

(Holland Road) – A contractor will have mobile lane closures on Holland Road eastbound between Manning Road and Manning Bridge Road until 3 p.m.

(Old Mill Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a road closure on Old Mill Road, Monday, September 10 through Wednesday, September 12 to replace a cross pipe in the 4500 block of Old Mill Road. Thru traffic will be re-routed to Pruden Boulevard/Route 460 and Old Myrtle Road.

(Freeman Mill Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Freeman Mill Road from Whaleyville Boulevard to Mineral Springs Road until 3:30 p.m.

(Pitchkettle Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering Paint Crew will have mobile lane closures on Pitchkettle Road between Ibis Boulevard and Kings Fork Road from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.

(White Marsh Road) – The northbound lane closure remains in place on White Marsh Road at Truman Road. Thru traffic will be detoured down Truman Road to South 6th Street to East Washington Street.

Ongoing Projects:

(Route 10) - Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagger operation on Route 10 between Everets Road and Kings Highway until 3 p.m. This work zone is an ongoing project set for completion by December of 2012.

(Shoulders Hill Road and Nansemond Parkway intersection) - A contractor will continue with ongoing work at the intersection of Shoulder's Hill Road and Nansemond Parkway.

(Mills Godwin Bridge, Route 17/Bridge Road) - A contractor will be removing and replacing the concrete bridge deck overlay material at the Mills Godwin Bridge, Route 17/Bridge Road. The work zone will be in effect from 7 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. The work project is expected to last 90 days, weather permitting, with flagging operations in place during work hours.
