ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (September 14, 2016) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Wednesday, September 14, 2016, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(North Main Street) – A contractor will have the northbound right lane closed on North Main Street between VDOT and Northgate Lane from 6 a.m. to 4 p.m., September 12th to September 16th.

(Charlotte Avenue) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Charlotte Avenue closed at Laurel Street and Lewis Avenue from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(North Main Street) – A contractor will have a right lane closure on northbound North Main Street from the 1200 block up to the Obici site lane closure near Northgate Lane from 6 a.m. to 12 p.m. for milling and overlaying entrances. The closure may extend past 12 p.m., September 12th through September 16th.

(College Drive) – A contractor will have a milling and paving operation on College Drive between Bridge Road and Hampton Roads Parkway overnight from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on westbound Route 58 between the Wilroy Road exit and the Route 13/32 Bypass for vegetation maintenance from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

(North Street) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on North Street at West Washington Street from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(College Drive) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering Paint Crew will have mobile lane closures on College Drive between Hampton Roads Parkway and Bridge Road from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.

(Chestnut Street) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Chestnut Street at West Washington Street from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Southwestern Boulevard) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Southwestern Boulevard for shoulder maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(College Drive) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on College Drive for vegetation maintenance from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

(Carolina Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Carolina Road between Cypress Chapel Road and Copeland Road for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.

(Nansemond Parkway) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering Signal crew will have alternating lane shifts eastbound and westbound on Nansemond Parkway between Nansemond Elementary and Nansemond River High School from 10:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Upcoming Projects:

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a northbound lane shift in the 5800 block of Godwin Boulevard to facilitate a storm drain installation from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m., Thursday September 15th through Friday, September 16th as well as on Monday, September 19th through Tuesday, September 20th.

Ongoing Projects:

(Arthur Drive) – A contractor will be reconstructing bridges over Spivey Run and Langston Swamp on Arthur Drive. A detour will be in place to direct motorists with the detour in place. This closure is expected to be complete by December 30, 2016.

(Highland Avenue) – A contractor will be installing a new pump station and sewer and water lines on Highland Avenue between Kingsboro Street and the end of Highland Avenue at the cul-de-sac. This project will continue through June 2017.

(Seaboard Trail) – A contractor will have the Seaboard Trail from Main Street to Moore Avenue closed to all pedestrians until further notice. The contractor is estimating a December completion date.
