SUFFOLK, VA (September 19, 2016) Paving has been canceled for this evening on College Drive due to the impending weather.

ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (September 19, 2016) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Monday, September 19, 2016, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Kings Highway) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Kings Highway for vegetation maintenance from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

(Nansemond Parkway) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Nansemond Parkway for vegetation maintenance from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

(West Washington Street) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on West Washington Street between Bute Street and Brewer Avenue from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(North Broad Street) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on North Broad Street between Third Avenue and West Washington Street from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Portsmouth Boulevard) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Portsmouth Boulevard between Nansemond Parkway and Route 58 for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a northbound lane shift in the 5800 block of Godwin Boulevard to facilitate a storm drain installation from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. Thursday, 9/15 and Friday, 9/16 and resume Monday, 9/19 and Tuesday, 9/20.

(College Drive) – A contractor will have a milling and paving operation on College Drive between Bridge Road and Hampton Roads Parkway overnight from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.

(North Main Street) – A contractor will have the northbound right lane closed on North Main Street between VDOT and Northgate Lane from 6 a.m. to 4 p.m. Moderate to heavy traffic patterns should be anticipated.

Ongoing Projects:

(Arthur Drive) – A contractor will be reconstructing bridges over Spivey Run and Langston Swamp on Arthur Drive. A detour will be in place to direct motorists with the detour in place. This closure is expected to be complete by December 30, 2016.

(Highland Avenue) – A contractor will be installing a new pump station and sewer and water lines on Highland Avenue between Kingsboro Street and the end of Highland Avenue at the cul-de-sac. This project will continue through June 2017.

(Seaboard Trail) – A contractor will have the Seaboard Trail from Main Street to Moore Avenue closed to all pedestrians until further notice. The contractor is estimating a December completion date.

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
