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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (September 25, 2014) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Thursday, September 25, 2014, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Various Locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have work projects in the following locations today: flagging operation on Whaley Street between Whaleyville Boulevard and Great Fork Road from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m., flagging operation in the 3000 block of White Marsh Road between Badger Road and Hosier Road from 12 p.m. to 3 p.m., mowing on Turlington Road and Arthur Drive, spraying for weeds on Carolina Road between Old Somerton Road and Copeland Road from 12 p.m. to 3 p.m.

(Various Locations) – Between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m., the Suffolk Department of Public Works will be hauling material to Blair Brothers on Route 460, perform a driveway repair on Gates Road, and a pothole repair on Elwood Road.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering Paint Crew will have a mobile lane closure on Route 58 at Holland Road from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will be working between on Route 58 between Brentwood Road and Elwood Road with left lane closures in both directions. On Friday, September 26, 2014, a contractor will stripe the eastbound side of Route 58 between Brentwood Road and Leafwood Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Various Locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will conduct work on Camellia Drive and Brentwood Road, will have a mobile operation on College Drive to repair potholes, and will be addressing weeds on Hampton Roads Parkway and College Drive from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(North Division Street) – A contractor will close the 100 block of North Division Street to thru traffic from 7:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. The street will be closed from East Washington Street to Bank Street Extended.

(Barrett Drive and Ronald Drive) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Barrett Drive and Ronald Drive from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Various Locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will be cutting limbs in the 300 block of Goodman Street and the 100 block of South Broad Street and will be working on Bunch Avenue from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Skeet Road and Woodrow Avenue) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will be working on Skeet Road and in the 200 block of Woodrow Avenue.

(Route 189, Route 272, and Route 58 Business) – A contractor will be mowing on Route 189/South Quay Road, Route 272/South Quay Road, and Route 58 Business near Holland Road.

Ongoing Projects:

(Turlington Road and Lake Speight Colony Neighborhood) – A contractor is working within the Lake Speight Colony Neighborhood as part of the sewer improvements for this neighborhood. Work is being conducted along Turlington Road and on Austin Drive. Anticipate detoured traffic on Austin Drive as the gravity sewer is being constructed. This work should be completed by December 1, 2014.

(Robbie Road) – The Suffolk Department of Public Works and a contractor will begin working on the bridge along Robbie Road, beginning on August 28, 2014. The project will require the closure of the roadway at the bridge site with work expected to be completed by November 18, 2014. A detour will be in place to route thru traffic.

(Manning Bridge Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Operations and a contractor will work on the bridge along Manning Bridge Road beginning Monday, July 28, 2014. The project will require the closure of the roadway at the bridge site and work is expected to be completed by November 28, 2014. A detour will be in place to route thru traffic.

(Various locations) – A contractor will be working on the installation of water and sewer mains for the Crittenden/Eclipse water and sewer extension project. The work hours will be from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday through Friday. The project will be ongoing until spring 2015. Flagging operations will be necessary on the following streets: Wigneil Street, Vine Street, Pike Street, Rivershore Drive, Dixon Road, Cross Street, Eclipse Drive, Bleakhorn Drive, and Darden Clubhouse Road during the period of construction.

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
