ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (July 24, 2017) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Monday, July 24, 2017, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Turlington Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 600 block of Turlington Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., July 24th through July 28th.

(Whaleyville Boulevard) – A contractor will have a mobile operation northbound and southbound on Whaleyville Boulevard for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. and 5 p.m.

(Freeman Mill Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have the 1500 block of Freeman Mill Road closed for bridge maintenance from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Holland Road) – A contractor will have an eastbound right lane closure in the 1600 block of Holland Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation eastbound and westbound on Route 58 between Brentwood Road and the Route 13/32 Bypass for pothole patching from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Ferry Point Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Ferry Point Road between Kings Highway and Crittenden Road for grading from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation westbound on Route 58 between the Chesapeake City line and the Route 13/32 Bypass for side cutting from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Magnolia Drive) – A contractor will be installing new storm pipe along Magnolia Drive from Old College Drive to Brookwood Drive starting the week of July 24th. Traffic control setup and a lane closure will be in the area with some anticipated moderate traffic congestion from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Upcoming Projects:

(Townpoint Road) – A contractor will be installing storm pipe across Townpoint Road at four crossings from Pughsville Road to Cove Street starting the week of July 31st. Traffic control setup and a lane closure will be in the area from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Ongoing Projects:

(Oak Ridge Neighborhood) – A contractor will be installing a water line in the Oak Ridge Neighborhood. Work will require lane closures throughout the neighborhood beginning on Westgate Avenue and is expected to continue through August.

(Bennetts Pasture Road and Woodhaven Drive) – Suffolk Department of Public Utilities will have either a flagging operation or will be closing the northbound lane along Bennetts Pasture Road in the vicinity of Woodhaven Drive between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. for utility work in this area. The Woodhaven Drive entrance into the Woodlands of Nansemond neighborhood will be closed beginning on Monday, July 24th for work at the entrance and will open by Friday, July 28th. The entrance out of the neighborhood will be open at night. Work will be complete by August 4th.

(College Drive and Harbour View Boulevard) – A contractor will have the right turn lanes closed northbound and southbound on College Drive at the intersection of Harbour View Boulevard. The right turn lane will be closed from eastbound Harbour View Boulevard to southbound College Drive. Westbound Harbour View Boulevard will be narrowed to one lane in this area. These closures will occur daily from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., July 17th through August 18th.
