SUFFOLK POLICE AND SUFFOLK FIRE & RESCUE RESPOND TO TWO VEHICLE ACCIDENT

SUFFOLK, Virginia (July 15, 2017) Suffolk Police and Suffolk Fire & Rescue responded to the scene of auto accident involving two vehicles in the 5000 block of Pruden Boulevard this morning. Suffolk Emergency Communications was notified of the accident at 7:58 a.m.

Officers determined that the driver of a passenger vehicle was pulling out of his driveway and was struck by a pickup truck pulling a trailer. Suffolk Fire & Rescue personnel provided emergency medical assessment and treatment for the male driver of the car who was ground transported to an area hospital with non-life threatening injuries. There were no injuries to the driver or the passenger of the truck.

Route 460/Pruden Boulevard in both directions was shutdown for approximately one hour. The driver of the car was cited for Failure to Yield.
