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### **ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS**

SUFFOLK, VA (August 2, 2017) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Wednesday, August 2, 2017, due to construction and maintenance projects.

**New Projects:**

(various locations) – A contractor will have a milling and paving operation which will require alternating lane closures between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. at the following locations: First Avenue, Second Avenue, Third Avenue, North Broad Street, Pitchkettle Road., and Brewer Avenue, July 31<sup>st</sup> through August 4<sup>th</sup>.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have an outside mobile lane closure eastbound on Route 58 between SPSA and the scales for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a mobile operation eastbound on Route 58 between the Route 13/32 Bypass and the Nansemond River overpass for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Turlington Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering Paint Crew will have mobile lane closures on Turlington Road between Carolina Road and Kilby Shores from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.

(Godwin Boulevard/Hillpoint Boulevard North) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering Signal Crew will be performing maintenance at the intersection on Godwin Boulevard and Hillpoint Boulevard North from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. All lanes and approaches will be affected intermittently for short periods.

(Pineview Road and Southwestern Boulevard) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation in the 8000 block of Pineview Road and Southwestern Boulevard for ditch maintenance.

(Eclipse Drive) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation in the 9000 block of Eclipse Drive for ditch maintenance from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.

(various locations) – A contractor will have shoulder closures at the following locations for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.: Lake Prince Road, Labrador Lane, Princeview Drive, Labrador Court, and Windemere Court.

(Kingsale Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Kingsale Road between Indian Trail and Carr Lane for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Magnolia Drive) – A contractor will be installing new storm pipe along Magnolia Drive from Old College Drive to Brookwood Drive starting the week of July 24th. Traffic control setup and a lane closure will be in place from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Townpoint Road) – A contractor will be installing storm pipe across Townpoint Road at four crossings from Pughsville Road to Cove Street starting the week of July 31st. Traffic control setup and a lane closure will be in the area from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have alternating lane closures eastbound and westbound on Route 58 between Manning Bridge Road and Lummis Road overnight for a milling and paving operation from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m., July 30<sup>th</sup> through August 4<sup>th</sup>.

(White Marsh Road) – A contractor will have alternating northbound and southbound lane closures in the 800 block of White Marsh Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., August 1<sup>st</sup> through August 3<sup>rd</sup>.

(Route 58 Business) – A contractor will have an eastbound mobile operation on Route 58 Business between the 7000 block and Manning Bridge Road for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a westbound right lane closure on Route 58 at the scales until 11 a.m. then will have a westbound left lane closure near the Wilroy exit from 11 a.m. to 12 p.m.

### **Ongoing Projects:**

(Oak Ridge Neighborhood) – A contractor will be installing an 8" water line in the Oakridge neighborhood. Work will require lane closures throughout the neighborhood beginning on Westgate Avenue and is expected to continue through August.

(College Drive and Harbour View Boulevard) – A contractor will have the Right Turn Lanes closed northbound and southbound on College Drive at the intersection of Harbour View Boulevard and the right turn lane will also be closed from eastbound Harbour View Boulevard to southbound College Drive. Westbound Harbour View Boulevard will also be narrowed to one lane in this area. This will allow for the beginning of construction of the College Drive Roundabout project. These closures will occur daily from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. through August 18<sup>th</sup>.

(Bennetts Pasture Road and Woodhaven Drive) – Suffolk Department of Public Utilities will have either a flagging operation or will be closing the northbound lane along Bennetts Pasture Road in the vicinity of Woodhaven Drive between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. for utility work in this area. The Woodhaven Drive entrance into the Woodlands of Nansemond neighborhood will be closed beginning on Monday July 31<sup>st</sup> for work at the entrance and will be open by Friday August 4<sup>th</sup>. The entrance out of the neighborhood will be open at night. Work will be complete by August 4<sup>th</sup>.

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
