SUFFOLK POLICE INVESTIGATING SHOOTING

SUFFOLK, Virginia (August 13, 2017) Suffolk Police are investigating a shooting that took place at the location of a party in the 8700 block of South Quay Road/Route 58 overnight. Suffolk Emergency Communications was notified of the incident at 12:13 a.m.

Suffolk Police advise that four adult male victims suffered gunshot wounds and were transported to area hospitals. One victim is currently in critical condition and one victim is still in the hospital with non-life threatening injuries. Two victims were treated and released. Suffolk Fire & Rescue personnel transported two of the victims following medical assessment and treatment. Two victims were transported by private vehicles to area hospitals. Carrsville Volunteer Fire personnel also responded to the scene.

The incident remains under investigation. No additional information is available.
