SUFFOLK, VA (August 15, 2017) - The affected portion of the roadway has reopened.

PORTION OF GODWIN BOULEVARD CLOSED DUE TO ACCIDENT

SUFFOLK, VA (August 15, 2017) Suffolk Police and Suffolk Fire & Rescue are on the scene in the 5000 block of Godwin Boulevard/Route 10 due to a head-on collision involving a Hyundai 4-door and a Ford Freestyle SUV.

Emergency Communications was made aware of the accident at 4:41 p.m. The roadway was completely shut down in both directions immediately following the accident however, traffic is now being alternated.

Suffolk Fire & Rescue personnel provided emergency medical assessment and treatment at the scene and two individuals were ground transported to local hospitals suffering from injuries believed to be non-life threatening.

The cause of the accident remains under investigation.
