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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (September 13, 2017) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Wednesday, September 13, 2017, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(West Washington Street) -- A contractor will have a flagging operation on West Washington Street between Broad Street and West Constance Road for milling and paving from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Laurel Avenue) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Laurel Avenue closed between Woodrow Avenue and Lewis Avenue for a cross drain installation from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Portsmouth Boulevard) – A contractor will have a left lane closure eastbound on Portsmouth Boulevard from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., September 11th through September 15th.

(Cedar Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Cedar Street closed between Charlotte Avenue and Lewis Avenue from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 13/32 Bypass) – A contractor will have mobile lane closures northbound on the Route 13/32 Bypass between Carolina Road and Route 58 from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations westbound and eastbound on Route 58 between Brentwood Road and Holland Road for pothole patching from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Portsmouth Boulevard and Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Portsmouth Boulevard and Godwin Boulevard for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

(Western Avenue) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering Paint Crew will have a work zone on Western Avenue between Main Street and West Constance Road from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.

(Kent Court and Calvert Court) – A contractor will have a milling operation on Kent Court and Calvert Court from 8 a.m. and 5 p.m.

(Pruden Boulevard) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have an eastbound right lane closure in the 2800 block of Pruden Boulevard for asphalt repair from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Ongoing Projects:

(Townpoint Road) – A contractor will have alternating lane closures on Townpoint Road between Pughsville Road and Cove Street to install new cross drains from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Godwin Boulevard) – A contractor will have an overnight flagging operation on Godwin Boulevard at the Reids Ferry Bridge for bridge maintenance beginning Sunday, August 13th. Work will take place Sunday through Thursday from 7:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.

(Oak Ridge Neighborhood) – A contractor will be installing an 8" water line in the Oakridge neighborhood. Work will be intermittent and require lane closures throughout the neighborhood and is expected to continue through the end of the year. Roads impacted at this time: Colonial Avenue, March Drive, Pond Drive, Sherwood Drive, Westwood Drive, and Grove Avenue.

(Magnolia Drive) – A contractor will be installing new storm pipes along Magnolia Drive from Old College Drive to Brookwood Drive starting the week of July 24th. Traffic control setup and a lane closure will be in place from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Work is expected to be complete by October 15th.

(College Drive and Harbour View Boulevard) – A contractor will have the right turn lanes closed northbound and southbound on College Drive at the intersection of Harbour View Boulevard and the right turn lane will also be closed from eastbound Harbour View Boulevard to southbound College Drive. Westbound Harbour View Boulevard will also be narrowed to one lane in this area. This will allow for the beginning of construction of the College Drive Roundabout project. These closures will occur daily from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and will be in place for several weeks.

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
