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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (October 6, 2017) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Friday, October 6, 2017, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Cedar Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Cedar Street closed between Raleigh Drive and Woodrow Avenue from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Laurel Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Lewis Street closed between Raleigh Drive and Woodrow Avenue from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Portsmouth Boulevard) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Portsmouth Boulevard and Route 58 eastbound and westbound, including ramps, for debris pickup from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Godwin Boulevard) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering Paint Crew will have mobile lane closures on Godwin Boulevard between Hannah Hunt Boulevard and Kensington Boulevard from 8:30 a.m. to 2 p.m.

(Manning Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Manning Road between Copeland Road and Mineral Spring Road for shoulder repair from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(College Drive) – A contractor will have a northbound right shoulder closure on College Drive from the intersection at Hampton Roads Crossing from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Quince Road) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Quince Road between Longstreet Lane and Lummis Road from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Lake Cohoon Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation in the 2000 block of Lake Cohoon Road for drainage maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Upcoming Projects:

(Townpoint Road) – A contractor will have alternating lane closures on Townpoint Road between Pughsville Road and Cove Street to install new cross drains from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Moderate to heavy traffic should be anticipated.

Ongoing Projects:

(Oak Ridge Neighborhood) – A contractor will be installing an 8" water line in the Oakridge neighborhood. Work will be intermittent and require lane closures throughout the neighborhood and is expected to continue through the end of the year.

(Magnolia Drive) – A contractor will be installing new storm pipes along Magnolia Drive from Old College Drive to Brookwood Drive starting the week of July 24th. Traffic control setup and a lane closure will be in place from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Work is expected to be complete by October 15th.

(Nansemond Parkway) – The Nansemond Roadway Expansion Project continues on Nansemond Parkway at the Chesapeake and Suffolk City line. Work is currently taking place in Chesapeake but may require periodic eastbound and westbound shoulder and/or lane closures in the in the City of Suffolk.

(College Drive and Harbour View Boulevard) – A contractor will have the right turn lanes closed northbound and southbound on College Drive at the intersection of Harbour View Boulevard and the right turn lane will also be closed from eastbound Harbour View Boulevard to southbound College Drive. Westbound Harbour View Boulevard will also be narrowed to one lane in this area. This will allow for the beginning of construction of the College Drive Roundabout project. These closures will occur daily from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and will be in place for several weeks.

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
