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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (October 24, 2017) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Tuesday, October 24, 2017, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Portsmouth Boulevard) – A contractor will have alternating lane closures eastbound and westbound on Portsmouth Boulevard from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Military Road) – A contractor will have the 400 block of Military Road closed from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Holladay Street) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Holladay Street from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Quaker Drive) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Quaker Drive between Lummis Road and Manning Road from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Lake Kilby Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Lake Kilby Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Grayson Court) – A contractor will have a lane closure in the 100 block of Grayson Court from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Military Road) – A contractor will have the 400 block of Military Road closed from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Rountree Crescent) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Rountree Crescent between Carolina Road and Greenway Road for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation eastbound on Route 58 at the Wilroy Road exit for asphalt repair from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Bridge Road, Godwin Boulevard, and Portsmouth Boulevard) – A contractor will have mobile operations on Bridge Road, Godwin Boulevard and Portsmouth Boulevard for vegetation maintenance and litter control from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

(Lake Kilby Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Lake Kilby Road between Lake Cohoon Road and Pitchkettle Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Upcoming Projects:

(Townpoint Road) – A contractor will have alternating lane closures on Townpoint Road between Pughsville Road and Cove Street to install new cross drains from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Moderate to heavy traffic should be anticipated.

(Pitchkettle Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Pitchkettle Road between Constance Road and Lincoln Avenue overnight from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m., October 26th through October 28th.

Ongoing Projects:

(Oak Ridge Neighborhood) – A contractor will be installing an 8" water line in the Oakridge neighborhood. Work will be intermittent and require lane closures throughout the neighborhood and is expected to continue through the end of the year.

(Nansemond Parkway) – The Nansemond Roadway Expansion Project continues on Nansemond Parkway between Helen Street and the Chesapeake City line. Work in this area will require periodic eastbound and westbound shoulder and/or lane closures.

(Magnolia Drive) – A contractor will be installing new storm pipes along Magnolia Drive from Old College Drive to Brookwood Drive. Traffic control setup and a lane closure will be in place from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Work is expected to be complete by November 15th.

(College Drive and Harbour View Boulevard) – A contractor will have the right turn lanes closed northbound and southbound on College Drive at the intersection of Harbour View Boulevard and the right turn lane will also be closed from eastbound Harbour View Boulevard to southbound College Drive. Westbound Harbour View Boulevard will also be narrowed to one lane in this area. This will allow for the beginning of construction of the College Drive Roundabout project. These closures will occur daily from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and will be in place for several weeks.

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
