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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (October 30, 2017) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Monday, October 30, 2017, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Liberty Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Liberty Street closed between East Washington Street and Bank Street from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Suffolk Police will assist directing traffic at the traffic light. Accommodations will be made for tractor trailers and school buses.

(Pinner Street) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Pinner Street between Bank Street and Finney Avenue from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a right lane closure westbound on Route 58 between Holy Neck Road and the Southampton County line from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Military Road) – A contractor will have the 400 block of Military Road closed for paving from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Quaker Drive) – A contractor will have a lane closure on Quaker Drive between Lummis Road and Porterfield Lane from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Lummis Road) – A contractor will have a lane closure on Lummis Road between Quaker Drive and Box Elder Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(West Constance Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 300 block of West Constance Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Badger Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Badger Road closed at the bridge for maintenance. Traffic will be detoured from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(New Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation in the 8000 block of New Road for paving from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Lake Kilby Road) – A contractor will have a lane closure in the 800 block of Lake Kilby Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Bridge Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Bridge Road between College Drive and the Isle of Wight line for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Whaleyville Boulevard) – Suffolk Department of Public works will have a flagging operation northbound and southbound on Whaleyville Boulevard for ditch maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Whaleyville Boulevard and the Route 13/32 Bypass) – A contractor will have mobile operations on Whaleyville Boulevard and the Route 13/32 Bypass for vegetation maintenance and Holland Road for litter control from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

(Pitchkettle Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Pitchkettle Road between Constance Road and Lincoln Avenue overnight from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m., October 30th through October 31st.

Upcoming Projects:

(Pitchkettle Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Utilities Line Maintenance will have Pughsville Road between Shoulders Hill Road and Townpoint Road closed to thru traffic for utility work from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. This work has not been scheduled as of yet.

(Manning Road) – A contractor will have Manning Road closed between Wilkins Drive and Route 58 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., October 31st to November 4th. Traffic will be detoured to Wilkins Drive.

(Townpoint Road) – A contractor will have a detour in effect on Townpoint Road near the intersections of John Street and Armstrong Avenue from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., November 1st and November 2nd, to construct new storm water crossings across Townpoint Road. This closure and detour may be extended due to unforeseen circumstances.

(Townpoint Road) – A contractor will have Townpoint Road closed just north of Cove Street on Friday, November 3rd from 9 a.m. to 4p.m. and just north of Miles Avenue on Monday, November 6th from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. to install new stormwater crossings across Townpoint Road. This closure and detour may be extended due to unforeseen circumstances.

Ongoing Projects:

(Oak Ridge Neighborhood) – A contractor will be installing an 8" water line in the Oakridge neighborhood. Work will be intermittent and require lane closures throughout the neighborhood and is expected to continue through the end of the year.

(Nansemond Parkway) – The Nansemond Roadway Expansion Project continues on Nansemond Parkway between Helen Street and the Chesapeake City line. Work in this area will require periodic eastbound and westbound shoulder and/or lane closures.

(Magnolia Drive) – A contractor will be installing new storm pipes along Magnolia Drive from Old College Drive to Brookwood Drive. Traffic control setup and a lane closure will be in place from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Work is expected to be complete by November 15th.

(College Drive and Harbour View Boulevard) – A contractor will have the right turn lanes closed northbound and southbound on College Drive at the intersection of Harbour View Boulevard and the right turn lane will also be closed from eastbound Harbour View Boulevard to southbound College Drive. Westbound Harbour View Boulevard will also be narrowed to one lane in this area. This will allow for the beginning of construction of the College Drive Roundabout project. These closures will occur daily from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and will be in place for several weeks.

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
