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UPDATE

SUFFOLK, VA (November 20, 2017) In addition to the work area below, the contractor will also have the eastbound Route 58 off ramp to Wilroy Road closed overnight for paving.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a right lane closure westbound on Route 58 between the Nansemond Parkway overpass and Route 10 for a paving operation overnight from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.

ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (November 20, 2017) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Monday, November 20, 2017, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Town Point Road) – Town Point Road will be closed to thru traffic just north of Cove Street on Monday and Tuesday from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Please anticipate moderate to heavy traffic in the area.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a mobile operation eastbound on Route 58 between the Route 13/32 Bypass and Chesapeake City line for litter control from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Broad Street) – A contractor will have a lane closure in the 700 block of Broad Street for utility work from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Lummis Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Lummis Road between Porterfield Lane and Route 58 from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Manning Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Manning Road between Copeland Road and Manning Bridge Road from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Nansemond Parkway) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Nansemond Parkway between Day Farm Lane and Hargrove Landing from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Bridge Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation northbound and southbound on Bridge Road for pothole patching from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Route 17) – A contractor will have alternating northbound lane closures on Route 17 at the I664 southbound on ramp for striping in the turn lane and thru lanes on Route 17. Work will take place Monday and Tuesday from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. and Wednesday from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. Weather permitting.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a right lane closure westbound on Route 58 between the Nansemond Parkway overpass and Route 10 for a paving operation overnight from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.

(Lake Kilby Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 800 block of Lake Kilby Road for a pole replacement from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Ongoing Projects:

(Oak Ridge Neighborhood) – A contractor will be installing an 8" water line in the Oak Ridge neighborhood. Work will be intermittent and require lane closures throughout the neighborhood and is expected to continue through the end of the year.

(Holland Road) – A contractor will have the westbound lane closed between the Lake Meade Bridge and St. Anne Avenue with traffic shifted to the center lane. Work will take place each day from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., however, the lane shift will be in place until approximately November 30.

(Nansemond Parkway) – The Nansemond Roadway Expansion Project continues on Nansemond Parkway between Helen Street and the Chesapeake City line. Work in this area will require periodic eastbound and westbound shoulder and/or lane closures.

(Magnolia Drive) – A contractor will be installing new storm pipes along Magnolia Drive from Old College Drive to Brookwood Drive. Traffic control setup and a lane closure will be in place from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Work is currently delayed and is expected to resume in approximately 30 days.

(College Drive and Harbour View Boulevard) – A contractor will have the Right Turn Lanes closed northbound and southbound on College Drive at the intersection of Harbour View Boulevard and the Right Turn Lane will also be closed from eastbound Harbour View Boulevard to southbound College Drive. Westbound Harbour View Boulevard will also be narrowed to one lane in this area. This will allow for the beginning of construction of the College Drive Roundabout project. These closures will occur daily from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and will be in place for several weeks. Moderate to heavy traffic should be anticipated.

(Bob White Lane) – A contractor will have Bob White Lane closed between Deanes Station Road and Shoulders Hill Road with traffic detouring thru Deanes Station Road and Rabey Farm Road. The closure will be permanent until approximately February 5, 2018. There will be a southbound lane shift on Shoulders Hill Road at the intersection of Shoulders Hill/Rabey Farm/Pughsville and the speed limit on Shoulders Hill Road will be temporarily lowered to 35 MPH.

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
