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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (November 22, 2017) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Wednesday, November 22, 2017, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Route 58/Portsmouth Boulevard) – City of Suffolk Public Works will have a mobile operation eastbound and westbound on Route 58 and Portsmouth Boulevard from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Town Point Road) – Town Point Road will be closed to thru traffic just north of Cove Street from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. today. Work will continue next week 12 p.m. to 4 p.m. on Monday and 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Wednesday through Friday. Please anticipate moderate to heavy traffic in the area.

(Manning Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Manning Road between Manning Bridge Road and Ronald Drive from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Manning Bridge Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Manning Bridge Road between Route 58 and Manning Road from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have an eastbound right lane closure on Route 58 between OKelly Drive and Longstreet Lane for pavement repair from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m.

(Lake Kilby Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 800 block of Lake Kilby Road for a pole replacement from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Route 17) – A contractor will have alternating northbound lane closures on Route 17 at the I664 southbound on ramp for striping in the turn lane and thru lanes on Route 17 from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

Upcoming Projects:

(College Drive) – A contractor will have a right lane closure northbound on College Drive between University Boulevard and Hampton Roads Parkway from 9 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

Ongoing Projects:

(Oak Ridge Neighborhood) – A contractor will be installing an 8" water line in the Oak Ridge neighborhood. Work will be intermittent and require lane closures throughout the neighborhood and is expected to continue through the end of the year.

(Holland Road) – A contractor will have the westbound lane closed between the Lake Meade Bridge and St. Anne Avenue. Traffic will be shifted to the center lane. Work will take place each day from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. however, the lane shift will be permanent until approximately November 30th.

(Nansemond Parkway) – The Nansemond Roadway Expansion Project continues on Nansemond Parkway between Helen Street and the Chesapeake City line. Work in

this area will require periodic eastbound and westbound shoulder and/or lane closures.

(Magnolia Drive) – A contractor will be installing new storm pipes along Magnolia Drive from Old College Drive to Brookwood Drive. Traffic control setup and a lane closure will be in place from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Work is currently delayed and is expected to resume on approximately December 4, 2017.

(College Drive and Harbour View Boulevard) – A contractor will have the Right Turn Lanes closed northbound and southbound on College Drive at the intersection of Harbour View Boulevard and the Right Turn Lane will also be closed from eastbound Harbour View Boulevard to southbound College Drive. Westbound Harbour View Boulevard will also be narrowed to one lane in this area. This will allow for the beginning of construction of the College Drive Roundabout project. These closures will occur daily from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and will be in place for several weeks. Moderate to heavy traffic should be anticipated.

(Bob White Lane) – A contractor will have Bob White Lane closed between Deanes Station Road and Shoulders Hill Road with traffic detouring thru Deanes Station Road and Rabey Farm Road. The closure will be permanent until approximately February 5, 2018. There will be a southbound lane shift on Shoulders Hill Road at the intersection of Shoulders Hill/Rabey Farm/Pughsville and the speed limit on Shoulders Hill Road will be temporarily lowered to 35 MPH.

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
