(Pughsville Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Utilities Line Maintenance will have a lane closure in the 3900 block of Pughsville Road from 12:30 p.m. to 2:30 p.m. for paving.

ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (November 28, 2017) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Tuesday, November 28, 2017, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Townpoint Road) – Townpoint Road will be closed to thru traffic just north of Cove Street from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., November 22 through December 1.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a stationary left lane closure eastbound on Route 58 between Route 460 and Wilroy Road for a milling and paving operation overnight from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m., November 27 through November 30.

(Harbour View Boulevard) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a lane closure in the 5800 block of Harbour View Boulevard for drainage maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Pruden Boulevard) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a right lane closure in the 2000 block of Pruden Boulevard for ditch maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(College Drive) – A contractor will have a right lane closure northbound on College Drive between University Boulevard and Hampton Roads Parkway from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., November 27 through December 1.

(Manning Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Manning Road between Manning Bridge Road and Ronald Drive from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Manning Bridge Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Manning Bridge Road between Route 58 and Manning Road from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Bank Street) – A contractor will have Bank Street closed between Pinner Street and Holladay Street for utility work from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Tuesday through Friday.

(Union Branch Road) – North Carolina Department of Transportation will have Union Branch Road closed for a cross drain install from 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Traffic will be detoured to Little Fork Road and Sweatt Road.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have right shoulder closures eastbound on Route 58 between Route 10 and Wilroy Road and between Wilroy Road and the Nansemond Parkway overpass from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Prudence Road) – A contractor will have a milling and paving operation on Prudence Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Holland Road/Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have westbound right lane closures in the 2100 and 6000 blocks of Holland Road/Route 58 for pavement repair from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Hosier Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Hosier Road between Meadow Country Road and White Marsh Road for side cutting from 12 p.m. to 3 p.m.

(Cherry Grove Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Cherry Grove Road between Greenway Road and Adams Swamp Road for side cutting from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Murphys Mill Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have flagging operations in the 900 and 1200 blocks of Murphys Mill Road for drainage maintenance from 8:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Lake Cohoon Road and Lake Kilby Road) – A contractor will have flagging operations at the intersection of Lake Cohoon Road and Lake Kilby Road and in the 800 block of Lake Kilby Road for a pole replacement from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(North James Drive) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 3000 block of North James Drive from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Portsmouth Boulevard) – A contractor will have a westbound right lane closure in the 1200 block of Portsmouth Boulevard from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(North Broad Street) – A contractor will have flagging operations in the 500 and 700 blocks of North Broad Street from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Ongoing Projects:

(Bob White Lane) – Beginning Tuesday, November 14, a contractor will have Bob White Lane closed between Deanes Station Road and Shoulders Hill Road with traffic detouring thru Deanes Station Road and Rabey Farm Road. The closure will be permanent until approximately February 5, 2018. There will be a southbound lane shift on Shoulders Hill Road at the intersection of Shoulders Hill/Rabey Farm/Pughsville and the speed limit on Shoulders Hill Road will be temporarily lowered to 35 miles per hour.

(Oak Ridge Neighborhood) – A contractor will be installing an 8" water line in the Oak Ridge neighborhood. Work will be intermittent and require lane closures throughout the neighborhood and is expected to continue through the end of the year.

(Holland Road) – A contractor will have the westbound lane closed between the Lake Meade Bridge and St. Anne Avenue with traffic shifted to the center lane. Work will take place each day from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., however, the lane shift will be in place until approximately November 30.

(Nansemond Parkway) – The Nansemond Roadway Expansion Project continues on Nansemond Parkway between Helen Street and the Chesapeake City line. Work in this area will require periodic eastbound and westbound shoulder and/or lane closures.

(Magnolia Drive) – A contractor will be installing new storm pipes along Magnolia Drive from Old College Drive to Brookwood Drive. Traffic control setup and a lane closure will be in place from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Work is currently delayed and is expected to resume on/around December 4, 2017.

(College Drive and Harbour View Boulevard) – A contractor will have the right turn lanes closed northbound and southbound on College Drive at the intersection of Harbour View Boulevard and the right turn lane will also be closed from eastbound Harbour View Boulevard to southbound College Drive. Westbound Harbour View Boulevard will also be narrowed to one lane in this area. This will allow for the beginning of construction of the College Drive Roundabout project. These closures will occur daily from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and will be in place for several weeks.

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
