POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAY – SUPER LOAD MOVE

SUFFOLK, VA (December 18, 2017) A super load move, involving the hauling of two modular units, could cause delays in traffic Tuesday, December 19, 2017 at approximately 10 a.m.

The trucks will begin the journey in North Carolina and will travel through Suffolk on the Franklin Bypass to eastbound Route 58 to the Holland Bypass to eastbound Route 58 to the Route 13/58/460 Suffolk Bypass to northbound Route 10/32 Godwin Boulevard to Isle of Wight County and will end the trip in Carrollton, Virginia.

One truck and load will measure 13 feet 6 inches tall, 16 feet wide, 100 feet long, and weigh 54,000 pounds. The other truck and load will measure 13 feet 6 inches tall, 16 feet wide, 100 feet long, and weigh 80,000 pounds.

The move will have certified front and rear escorts and a Police escort.
