SUFFOLK FIRE & RESCUE RESPOND TO RESIDENTIAL STRUCTURE FIRE - CAMP POND ROAD

SUFFOLK, VA (December 19, 2017) Suffolk Fire & Rescue responded to a residential structure fire in the 11000 block of Camp Pond Road this afternoon. Emergency Dispatchers were notified of the incident at 4:29 p.m.

Suffolk Fire & Rescue Battalion Chief David Harrell noted the first unit arrived on the scene at 4:45 p.m. and found the single wide trailer fully involved. The fire would extend to the wood line. The fire was marked under control at 5:15 p.m. No one was home at the time of the fire. The single occupant will be displaced and will stay with family. There were no injuries as a result of the fire.

Units from Suffolk Fire & Rescue, Holland Volunteer Fire Department, Whaleyville Volunteer Fire Department and Carrsville Volunteer Fire Department responded to the incident. Units included Battalion 1, Engine 8, Medic 8A, Engine 2, Engine 1, Tanker 7, EMS 1, Tanker 1, Safety 1, Reserve 8, Brush 7, and Fire Marshal 4.

The Fire Marshal's Office is investigating the cause of the fire.
