### **SUFFOLK FIRE & RESCUE RESPOND TO RESIDENTIAL STRUCTURE FIRE – GODWIN BOULEVARD**

SUFFOLK, VA (January 17, 2018) Suffolk Fire & Rescue responded to a residential structure fire in the 4400 block of Godwin Boulevard this evening, Wednesday, January 17, 2018. Emergency Dispatchers were notified of the incident at 7:38 p.m.

Suffolk Fire & Rescue Battalion Chief William Kessinger noted the first fire unit arrived on the scene at 7:45 p.m. and found the two story structure fully involved. The fire was marked under control at 9:35 p.m. The single occupant was not at home at the time of the fire and is displaced and will be staying with a relative. There were no injuries as a result of the fire.

Battalion 1, Engine 1, Engine 6, Ladder 6, EMS 1, Engine 29, Tanker 9, Medic 6A, Rescue 1, Tanker 1, Brush 9, Fire Marshal 1, Fire Marshal 6 and Safety 1 responded to the incident.

The Fire Marshal's Office is investigating the cause of the fire.
