FREE SPRING BREAK ACTIVITIES PROVIDED BY SUFFOLK PUBLIC LIBRARY

SUFFOLK, VA (March 28, 2018) For those not traveling out of town over Suffolk Public Schools' Spring Break week, a staycation can be just as fun. Suffolk Public Library has put together a weeklong list of free events designed to get people out of the house to do something interactive and different each day.

The week kicks off Monday, April 2, 2018 with a movie day at both Morgan Memorial Library and North Suffolk Library with family-friendly films running from 10:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. at both locations. Movies such as Moana (PG), Descendants (G), and Jumanji (PG-13) will be shown accompanied by snacks. A full list of movie titles and times can be found on the library's website or by contacting the library.

Both Tuesday, April 3rd, and Thursday, April 5th, focuses on creativity with Creation Stations set up at all three library locations. All ages can drop in to create stories, design art, construct building projects, and more. Creation Stations will be available at Morgan Memorial Library and North Suffolk Library from 10:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. and at Chuckatuck Library from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Wednesday, April 4th features a day party with games, music, karaoke and fun for the entire family. This event will be held at both Morgan Memorial Library and North Suffolk Library from 4:00 p.m. to 5:30 p.m.

On Friday, April 6th from 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. there will be outdoor games and activities at all three library locations with a different focus at each one. Chuckatuck Library will feature campfire games and s'mores, Morgan Memorial Library will have life-size games and sidewalk art, and North Suffolk Library will challenge participants with a library obstacle course and scavenger hunt.

To wrap up Spring Break there will be a Harry Potter Potions Class on Saturday, April 7th. Harry Potter fans of all ages are welcome to participate in this hands-on class where science experiments take the form of potions. The class will run from 10:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. at North Suffolk Library and from 2:00 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. at Morgan Memorial Library.
