### **POLICE SEEK PUBLIC'S ASSISTANCE IDENTIFYING CREDIT CARD FRAUD SUBJECTS**

SUFFOLK, VA (April 9, 2018) Suffolk Police are asking for the public's assistance in identifying several subjects believed to be involved in at least two thefts from motor vehicles, as well as related credit card fraud offenses.

These offenses occurred in the 2800 block of Godwin Boulevard on March 12<sup>th</sup>, 16<sup>th</sup>, and 21<sup>st</sup> where victims found a window of their vehicle smashed and personal items removed. The subjects were observed in several vehicles during the commission of the offenses, including a red sedan, a dark colored sedan, and a dark SUV.
