UPDATE

SUFFOLK, VA (May 1, 2018) Suffolk Fire & Rescue is currently on scene as the environmental clean-up is considered a hazmat incident. Upon preliminary investigation it was determined that the Valley Proteins, Inc. open-top tractor trailer's load shifted while braking for a vehicle in front of them causing a portion of the contents to spill out onto the roadway. The contents included animal renderings and Valley Proteins, Inc. will be handling the clean-up of the scene. The spill poses no danger to the public.

PORTION OF GODWIN BOULEVARD CLOSED

SUFFOLK, VA (May 1, 2018) Public Works Operations is providing traffic control for an environmental cleanup on Godwin Boulevard (Route 10) at the intersection of Centerbrooke Lane. This closure is expected to be in place for several hours. The affected lanes include the eastbound right lane and right turn lane on Godwin Boulevard onto Centerbrooke Lane.
