### **ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS**

SUFFOLK, VA (May 9, 2018) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Wednesday, May 9, 2018, due to construction and maintenance projects.

**New Projects:**

(Holland Road) – A contractor will have alternating lane closures on Holland Road between the 1200 block and West Constance Road for milling and paving from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., May 7 through May 10.

(Harbour View Boulevard) – A contractor will have a right lane closure in the 5800 block of Harbour View Boulevard for a sidewalk and driveway apron installation from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Finney Avenue) – A contractor will have Finney Avenue closed between Pinner Street and Holladay Street from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Indian Trail) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 2300 block of Indian Trail from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a mobile operation westbound on Route 58 between the Chesapeake City line and Route 10 for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Market Street) – A contractor will have the sidewalk and a right eastbound lane closure on Market Street at the intersection of Main Street and a right northbound lane closure on North Main Street at Market Street from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Knotts Neck Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Knotts Neck Road from 12 p.m. to 4 p.m. The contractor will also be maintaining vegetation at the following locations from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m. with no traffic control needed: Knotts Creek Lane, Cook Road, and Walden Road.

(Whaleyville Boulevard and Carolina Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have flagging operations in the 7800 block of Whaleyville Boulevard from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. and the 3800 block of Carolina Road from 12 p.m. to 3 p.m. for vegetation maintenance.

(Old Mill Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Old Mill Road for pothole patching from 12 p.m. to 3 p.m.

(various locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Bridge Road, Shoulders Hill Road and Nansemond Parkway for pothole patching from 12 p.m. to 3 p.m.

(Suburban Drive and Wilroy Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Suburban Drive and Wilroy Road for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Shoulders Hill Road) – Beginning, Tuesday, May 8. Commonwealth Railroad will have intermittent closures on Shoulders Hill Road between Nansemond Parkway and Dutchess Way while equipment is transported to and from the train derailment site. The closure times will vary but are not expected to exceed an hour in duration. Traffic will be detoured through the Suffolk Meadows Neighborhood during the closures and should be expected for the next two days.

(Northbrooke Avenue) – A contractor will have Northbrooke Avenue closed between Route 58 and Colonial Drive from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation eastbound and westbound on Route 58 between Portsmouth Boulevard and the Chesapeake City line for debris pick up from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

**Upcoming Projects:**

(Page Place) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 300 block of Page Place from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

**Ongoing Projects:**

(Old College Drive) – A contractor will be installing storm water piping and will have Old College Drive closed between Magnolia Drive and Camelia Drive, Monday through Friday, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., until May 25.

(Red Oak Lane) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Operations will have Red Oak Lane closed to thru traffic for a storm water pipe replacement. Work will take place Monday thru Saturday between the hours of 7 a.m. and 6 p.m. and is expected to be complete May 31, weather permitting. Accommodations will be made for residents.

(Shoulders Hill Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 5600 block of Shoulders Hill Road for a sewer line installation from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Work is expected to be complete May 11, weather permitting.

(West Constance Road) – A contractor will be installing gas lines on West Constance Road between Holland Road and Main Street. This work will take place between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. and will require periodic lane closures.

(Old Somerton Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Old Somerton Road from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. The water line installation in this area will continue through July 2018.

(Longstreet Lane) – Longstreet Lane is closed at the bridge over Somerton Creek, between Pittmantown Road and Butler Drive, for bridge repair. Suffolk Department of Public Works Operations anticipates a June 2018 opening.

(Hobson Water Main Extension Project) - A contractor will be installing a water main in the Hobson neighborhood to include Sawmill Point Road, Hudgins Circle and Macedonia Avenue. Work will be intermittent and require lane closures throughout the neighborhood. All work is expected to be completed in May 2018.

(College Drive and Harbour View Boulevard) – A contractor will have a new roundabout pattern in place at the intersection of Harbour View Boulevard and College Drive. The contractor will be conducting construction activities inside the roundabout center as well as off to the sides of the road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Oak Ridge Neighborhood) – A contractor will be installing an 8" water line in the Oak Ridge neighborhood. Work will be intermittent and require lane closures throughout the neighborhood and is expected to continue through July 2018.

(Nansemond Parkway) – The Nansemond Roadway Expansion Project continues on Nansemond Parkway between Shoulders Hill Road and the Chesapeake City line. Work in this area will require periodic eastbound and westbound shoulder and/or lane closures.
