### **ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS**

SUFFOLK, VA (June 4, 2018) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Monday, June 4, 2018, due to construction and maintenance projects.

**New Projects:**

(Bennetts Pasture Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Bennetts Pasture Road between Windjammer Road and Kings Highway for milling and paving from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., May 31 through June 6. Work will continue through the weekend. Accommodations will be made for vehicles entering and exiting the school.

(Bank Street Extended) – A contractor will have Bank Street Extended closed between North Lloyd Street and North 4<sup>th</sup> Street from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Pittmantown Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 3500 block of Pittmantown Road from 8 a.m. to 11 a.m.

(Pinner Street) – A contractor will have Pinner Street closed between Bank Street and Finney Avenue from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(various locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Manning Road, Indian Trail, Old Mill Road, and Old Myrtle Road for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(North Lloyd Street) – A contractor will have North Lloyd Street closed between East Washington Street and Railroad Avenue from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Oakridge Neighborhood) – A contractor will have milling and paving operations in the Oakridge Neighborhood beginning Monday, June 4 at 7 a.m. with alternating lane closures on Northbrooke Avenue between Holland Road and the 300 block. The work will continue through June 30.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will be working off the road in the intersections of Bridge Road and College Drive as well as Bridge Road and Breezeport Way from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Copeland Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Copeland Road between Lummis Road and Manning Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(various locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Murphys Mill Road, Girl Scout Road, Lake Prince Drive, Exeter Drive, and Gardner Lane spraying vegetation at the bridges from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue closed between North Broad Street and Brewer Avenue for drainage maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., June 4 through June 8.

(Indian Trail and Lake Prince Drive) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations in the 3000 to 5000 blocks of Indian Trail from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. and in the 4300 block of Lake Prince Drive from 1 p.m. to 3 p.m. for ditch maintenance.

(Carolina Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering Paint Crew will have mobile lane closures on Carolina Road between Turlington Road and Whaleyville Boulevard from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.

(Carolina Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation northbound on Carolina Road between Turlington Road and the Route 13/32 Bypass for ditch maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Carolina Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a northbound right lane closure on Carolina Road in the 600 block for driveway pipe installations from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation eastbound and westbound on Route 58 between Holland Road and Pioneer Road for pothole patching from 12 p.m. to 3:30 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on eastbound and westbound Route 58 between Route 460 and the Chesapeake City line for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

**Ongoing Projects:**

(Red Oak Lane) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Operations will have Red Oak Lane closed to thru traffic for a storm water pipe replacement and is expected to be complete June 30, weather permitting. Accommodations will be made for residents.

(West Constance Road) – A contractor will be installing gas lines on West Constance Road between Holland Road and Main Street. This work will take place between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. and will require periodic lane closures.

(Old Somerton Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Old Somerton Road from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. The water line installation in this area will continue through July 2018.

(Longstreet Lane) – Longstreet Lane is closed at the bridge over Somerton Creek, between Pittmantown Road and Butler Drive, for bridge repair. Suffolk Department of Public Works Operations anticipates a June 2018 opening.

(Hobson Water Main Extension Project) - A contractor will be installing a water main in the Hobson neighborhood to include Sawmill Point Road, Hudgins Circle and Macedonia Avenue. Work will be intermittent and require lane closures throughout the neighborhood. All work is expected to be completed in June 2018.

(Oak Ridge Neighborhood) – A contractor will be installing an 8" water line in the Oak Ridge neighborhood. Work will be intermittent and require lane closures throughout the neighborhood and is expected to continue through July 2018.

(Nansemond Parkway) – The Nansemond Roadway Expansion Project continues on Nansemond Parkway between Shoulders Hill Road and the Chesapeake City line. Work in this area will require periodic eastbound and westbound shoulder and/or lane closures.
