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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (June 6, 2018) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Wednesday, June 6, 2018, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Bennetts Pasture Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Bennetts Pasture Road between Windjammer Road and Kings Highway for milling and paving from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., May 31 through June 6. Accommodations will be made for vehicles entering and exiting the school.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have the westbound turn lane closed on Bridge Road at Breezeport Way from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Copeland Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Copeland Road between Lummis Road and Manning Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(2nd Avenue) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have 2nd Avenue closed between North Broad Street and Brewer Avenue for drainage maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., June 4 through June 8.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on eastbound and westbound Route 58 between Wilroy Road and the Chesapeake City line for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(College Drive) – A contractor have a shoulder closure on College Drive at the eastbound onramp to Route 164 from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Portsmouth Boulevard) – A contractor will have a westbound right lane closure in the 1200 block of Portsmouth Boulevard from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Hosier Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering Paint Crew will have mobile lane closures on Hosier Road between Webb Street and Meadow Country Road from 12:30 pm. to 3:30 p.m.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have a northbound right lane closure on Bridge Road between the Bennetts Creek Bridge and Windward Lane for a milling and paving operation overnight from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.

(East Constance Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 500 block of East Constance Road from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Camp Pond Road) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Camp Pond Road between Gates Road and the North Carolina State line from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Bridge Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a right lane closure northbound on Bridge Road between Shoulders Hill Road and Bennetts Pasture Road for ditch maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Carolina Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a southbound lane closure on Carolina Road between the Route 13/32 Bypass and Turlington Road for ditch maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Bank Street and Pinner Street) – A contractor has the intersection of Bank Street and Pinner Street closed with detours in place until approximately 4 p.m.

(Lummis Road, Copeland Road, Pitchkettle Road, Murphys Mill Road, Joshua Lane, White Marsh Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Lummis Road, Copeland Road, Pitchkettle Road, Murphys Mill Road, Joshua Lane, and White Marsh Road for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(First Avenue) – A contractor will have First Avenue closed between North Broad Street and the dead end from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Holland Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering Sign and Paint Crews will have a mobile operation eastbound and westbound on Holland Road between Chappell Drive and Pioneer Road from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m. to install signs.

(Bank Street Extended) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Bank Street Extended closed between North Capitol Street and North 4th Street from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Railroad Avenue) – A contractor will have Railroad Avenue closed between North Capitol Street and North Lloyd Street from 8 a.m. to 11 a.m.

(Bank Street Extended) – A contractor will have Bank Street Extended closed between North Division Street and North Lloyd Street from 8 a.m. to 11 a.m.

Upcoming Projects:

(Pruden Boulevard) – Suffolk Department of Public Works and a contractor will have the 4200 block of Pruden Boulevard reduced to one lane in each direction for a stormwater pipe replacement from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, June 10. Variable message boards have been placed to notify motorists. Motorists should expect small delays during this time.

Ongoing Projects:

(Oakridge Neighborhood) – A contractor will have milling and paving operations in the Oakridge Neighborhood beginning Monday, June 4 at 7 a.m. with flagging operations on Northbrooke Avenue between Holland Road and the 300 block. The work will continue through June 30.

(Red Oak Lane) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Operations will have Red Oak Lane closed to thru traffic for a storm water pipe replacement and is expected to be complete June 30, weather permitting. Accommodations will be made for residents.

(West Constance Road) – A contractor will be installing gas lines on West Constance Road between Holland Road and Main Street. This work will take place between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. and will require periodic lane closures.

(Old Somerton Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Old Somerton Road from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. The water line installation in this area will continue through July 2018.

(Longstreet Lane) – Longstreet Lane is closed at the bridge over Somerton Creek, between Pittmantown Road and Butler Drive, for bridge repair. Suffolk Department of Public Works Operations anticipates a June 2018 opening.

(Hobson Water Main Extension Project) - A contractor will be installing a water main in the Hobson neighborhood to include Sawmill Point Road, Hudgins Circle and Macedonia Avenue. Work will be intermittent and require lane closures throughout the neighborhood. All work is expected to be completed in June 2018.

(Oak Ridge Neighborhood) – A contractor will be installing an 8" water line in the Oak Ridge neighborhood. Work will be intermittent and require lane closures throughout the neighborhood and is expected to continue through July 2018.

(Nansemond Parkway) – The Nansemond Roadway Expansion Project continues on Nansemond Parkway between Shoulders Hill Road and the Chesapeake City line. Work in this area will require periodic eastbound and westbound shoulder and/or lane closures.

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
