ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (June 7, 2018) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Thursday, June 7, 2018, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will be working off the roadway on Bridge Road at Breezeport Way from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. No traffic control needed.

(College Drive) – A contractor will be working off the road on College Drive at the eastbound on ramp to Route 164 from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. No traffic control needed.

(Portsmouth Boulevard) – A contractor will have a westbound right lane closure in the 1200 block of Portsmouth Boulevard from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have a southbound right lane closure on Bridge Road between the Bennetts Creek Bridge and Windward Lane for a milling and paving operation overnight from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.

(Rountree Crescent) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation in the 200 - 500 blocks of Rountree Crescent for asphalt repair from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Airport Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Airport Road between Skeetertown Road and Copeland Road for ditch maintenance from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Camp Pond Road, Corinth Chapel Road and Starcher Court) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Camp Pond Road, Corinth Chapel Road and Starcher Court for pothole patching from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Bridge Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a right lane closure northbound on Bridge Road between Shoulders Hill Road and Bennetts Pasture Road for ditch maintenance from 8:30 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Old Myrtle Road and Kings Fork Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Old Myrtle Road and Kings Fork Road for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(2nd Avenue) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have 2nd Avenue closed between North Broad Street and Brewer Avenue for drainage maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(First Avenue) – A contractor will have First Avenue closed between North Broad Street and the dead end from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Shoulders Hill Road) – A contractor will have a lane closure in the 5600 block of Shoulders Hill Road for asphalt repair from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Route 58 eastbound and westbound between Holland Road and Route 460 for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Upcoming Projects:

(Pruden Boulevard) – Suffolk Department of Public Works and a contractor will have the 4200 block of Pruden Boulevard reduced to one lane in each direction for a stormwater pipe replacement from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, June 10. Variable message boards have been placed to notify motorists. Motorists should expect small delays during this time.

Ongoing Projects:

(Portsmouth Boulevard) – A contractor will have a westbound right shoulder closure in the 1200 block of Portsmouth Boulevard.

(Oak Ridge Neighborhood) – A contractor will have milling and paving operations in the Oak Ridge Neighborhood beginning Monday, June 4 at 7 a.m. with flagging operations on Northbrooke Avenue between Holland Road and the 300 block. The work will continue through June 30.

(Red Oak Lane) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Operations will have Red Oak Lane closed to thru traffic for a storm water pipe replacement and is expected to be complete June 30, weather permitting. Accommodations will be made for residents.

(West Constance Road) – A contractor will be installing gas lines on West Constance Road between Holland Road and Main Street. This work will take place between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. and will require periodic lane closures.

(Old Somerton Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Old Somerton Road from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. The water line installation in this area will continue through July 2018.

(Longstreet Lane) – Longstreet Lane is closed at the bridge over Somerton Creek, between Pittmantown Road and Butler Drive, for bridge repair. Suffolk Department of Public Works Operations anticipates a June 2018 opening.

(Hobson Water Main Extension Project) - A contractor will be installing a water main in the Hobson neighborhood to include Sawmill Point Road, Hudgins Circle and Macedonia Avenue. Work will be intermittent and require lane closures throughout the neighborhood. All work is expected to be completed in June 2018.

(Oak Ridge Neighborhood) – A contractor will be installing an 8" water line in the Oak Ridge neighborhood. Work will be intermittent and require lane closures throughout the neighborhood and is expected to continue through July 2018.

(Nansemond Parkway) – The Nansemond Roadway Expansion Project continues on Nansemond Parkway between Shoulders Hill Road and the Chesapeake City line. Work in this area will require periodic eastbound and westbound shoulder and/or lane closures.
