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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (June 13, 2018) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Wednesday, June 13, 2018, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(College Drive) – A contractor will have a shoulder closure on College Drive between the westbound off ramp to Route 164 and University Boulevard from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Main Street) – A contractor will have a southbound right lane closure on Main Street at Mahan Street from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Copeland Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Copeland Road between Lummis Road and Manning Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(College Drive) – A contractor will have a right lane closure northbound on College Drive at the Route 664 interchange from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Longstreet Lane) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 3200 block of Longstreet Lane from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Highland Avenue) – A contractor will have a camera crew on Highland Avenue between Katherine Street and Lakeside Street from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Nansemond Avenue) – A contractor will have a camera crew on Nansemond Avenue between Katherine Street and Kingsboro Street from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Kingsboro Street) – A contractor will have a camera crew on Kingsboro Street between East Constance Road and East Pinner Street from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Springfield Terrace) – A contractor will be working in the grass shoulder in the 100 block of Springfield Terrace from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. No traffic control needed.

(Lake Prince Drive) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering's paint crew will have a flagging operation on Lake Prince Drive between Labrador Lane and Milners Road from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.

(Shoulders Hill Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Shoulders Hill Road between Nansemond Parkway and the railroad tracks from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Wilroy Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Wilroy Road between Progress Road and the 2300 block for ditch maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Suffolk Police Department will be on scene assisting with traffic control at the intersection of Wilroy Road and Progress Road.

(Harbour View Boulevard) – A contractor will have alternating eastbound and westbound lane closures on Harbour View Boulevard between Hampton Roads Parkway and North River Road for a milling and paving operation overnight from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. Work is expected to be complete Sunday, June 17th at 6 a.m.

(Pruden Boulevard) – Suffolk Department of Public Works and a contractor will have the 4200 block of Pruden Boulevard reduced to one lane in each direction for a storm water pipe replacement from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Work is expected to be complete Thursday, June 14th at 6 a.m. Variable Message Boards have been placed to notify motorists. Motorists should expect small delays during this time.

(Carolina Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a southbound lane closure in the 600 block of Carolina Road for a drainage pipe installation from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Carolina Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a northbound lane closure on Carolina Road between Turlington Road and Tyson Court for a drainage maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Indian Trail) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 2300 block of Indian Trail from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Route 13/32 Bypass) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on the Route 13/32 Bypass spraying vegetation on bridges and overpasses from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m.

(Bridge Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Bridge Road between Isle of Wight County line and College Drive spraying vegetation on bridges and overpasses from 12 p.m. to 3 p.m.

(Glen Haven Drive, Deer Path Road, Wedgwood Drive and Lucy Cross Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Glen Haven Drive, Deer Path Road, Wedgwood Drive and Lucy Cross Road for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(College Drive) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on College Drive for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have mobile operations westbound then returning eastbound on Route 58 between Route 460 and Holland Road for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Ongoing Projects:

(Portsmouth Boulevard) – A contractor will have a westbound right shoulder closure in the 1200 block of Portsmouth Boulevard.

(Oak Ridge Neighborhood) – A contractor will have milling and paving operations in the Oak Ridge Neighborhood beginning Monday, June 4 at 7 a.m. with flagging operations on Northbrooke Avenue between Holland Road and the 300 block. The work will continue through June 30.

(Red Oak Lane) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Operations will have Red Oak Lane closed to thru traffic for a storm water pipe replacement and is expected to be complete June 30, weather permitting. Accommodations will be made for residents.

(West Constance Road) – A contractor will be installing gas lines on West Constance Road between Holland Road and Main Street. This work will take place between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. and will require periodic lane closures.

(Old Somerton Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Old Somerton Road from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. The water line installation in this area will continue through July 2018.

(Longstreet Lane) – Longstreet Lane is closed at the bridge over Somerton Creek, between Pittmantown Road and Butler Drive, for bridge repair. Suffolk Department of Public Works Operations anticipates a June 2018 opening.

(Hobson Water Main Extension Project) - A contractor will be installing a water main in the Hobson neighborhood to include Sawmill Point Road, Hudgins Circle and Macedonia Avenue. Work will be intermittent and require lane closures throughout the neighborhood. All work is expected to be completed in June 2018.

(Oak Ridge Neighborhood) – A contractor will be installing an 8" water line in the Oak Ridge neighborhood. Work will be intermittent and require lane closures throughout the neighborhood and is expected to continue through July 2018.

(Nansemond Parkway) – The Nansemond Roadway Expansion Project continues on Nansemond Parkway between Shoulders Hill Road and the Chesapeake City line. Work in this area will require periodic eastbound and westbound shoulder and/or lane closures.

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
