**ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS**

SUFFOLK, VA (June 20, 2018) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Wednesday, June 20, 2018, due to construction and maintenance projects.

**New Projects:**

(College Drive) – A contractor will be working in the median on College Drive at the westbound off ramp to Route 164 and at Hampton Roads Parkway from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. No traffic control needed.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will be working in the shoulder on Bridge Road at Breezeport Way from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. No traffic control needed.

(Indian Trail) – A contractor will have a mobile lane closure in the 2200-2600 block of Indian Trail from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Red Oak Lane) – A contractor will have a milling and paving operation on Red Oak Lane from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Portsmouth Boulevard) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a westbound right lane closure in the 1000 block of Portsmouth Boulevard for drainage maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Holland Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation westbound on Holland Road between the 7600 block and Elwood Road for drainage maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Holland Road) – A contractor will have an eastbound right lane closure in the 2300 block of Holland Road, between Manning Bridge Road and just beyond the 7-Eleven, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(West Constance Road) – A contractor will have a westbound lane closure on West Constance Road between Second Avenue and Washington Street from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. This work will require a temporary closure of the Suffolk Shopping Center entrance. During this time traffic will be detoured thru another entrance.

(Highland Avenue) – A contractor will have a camera and drilling crew on Highland Avenue between Katherine Street and Lakeside Street from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. No traffic control needed.

(Nansemond Avenue) – A contractor will have a camera and drilling crew on Nansemond Avenue between Katherine Street and Kingsboro Street from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. No traffic control needed.

(Nansemond Avenue) – A contractor will have a camera crew on Nansemond Avenue between Lakeside Street and Elizabeth Street from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. No traffic control needed.

(Kingsboro Street) – A contractor will have a camera crew on Kingsboro Street between East Constance Road and East Pinner Street from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. No traffic control needed.

(Elizabeth Street) – A contractor will have a camera crew on Elizabeth Street between Nansemond Avenue and East Constance Road from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Longstreet Lane) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a right shoulder closure in the 1800 block of Longstreet Lane for parked equipment until 4 p.m.

(North Lloyd Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have the 100 block of North Lloyd Street closed with a detour from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Pearl Street) – A contractor will have Pearl Street closed overnight with a detour in place until 4 p.m. Thursday, June 21st.

(Grove Avenue) – A contractor will have Pearl Street closed overnight with a detour in place until 4 p.m. Thursday, June 21st.

(Shoulders Hill Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering's paint crew will have mobile lane closures on Shoulders Hill Road between Bridge Road and Belmont Boulevard from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.

(Tree Lane, Cumberland Lane, Old Somerton Road, Airport Road, Dutch Road, Longstreet Lane) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Tree Lane, Cumberland Lane, Old Somerton Road, Airport Road, Dutch Road and Longstreet Lane for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(College Drive/Bridge Road) – A contractor will have mobile operations on College Drive and Bridge Road for vegetation maintenance and litter control from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a mobile operation eastbound on Route 58 between Southampton County line and Holland Road for vegetation maintenance and litter control from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

**Ongoing Projects:**

(Portsmouth Boulevard) – A contractor will have a westbound right shoulder closure in the 1200 block of Portsmouth Boulevard.

(Oak Ridge Neighborhood) – A contractor will have milling and paving operations in the Oak Ridge Neighborhood beginning Monday, June 4 at 7 a.m. with flagging operations on Northbrooke Avenue between Holland Road and the 300 block. The work will continue through June 30.

(Red Oak Lane) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Operations will have Red Oak Lane closed to thru traffic for a storm water pipe replacement and is expected to be complete June 30, weather permitting. Accommodations will be made for residents.

(West Constance Road) – A contractor will be installing gas lines on West Constance Road between Holland Road and Main Street. This work will take place between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. and will require periodic lane closures.

(Old Somerton Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Old Somerton Road from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. The water line installation in this area will continue through July 2018.

(Hobson Water Main Extension Project) - A contractor will be installing a water main in the Hobson neighborhood to include Sawmill Point Road, Hudgins Circle and Macedonia Avenue. Work will be intermittent and require lane closures throughout the neighborhood. All work is expected to be completed in June 2018.

(Oak Ridge Neighborhood) – A contractor will be installing an 8" water line in the Oak Ridge neighborhood. Work will be intermittent and require lane closures throughout the neighborhood and is expected to continue through July 2018.

(Nansemond Parkway) – The Nansemond Roadway Expansion Project continues on Nansemond Parkway between Shoulders Hill Road and the Chesapeake City line. Work in this area will require periodic eastbound and westbound shoulder and/or lane closures.
