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### **ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS**

SUFFOLK, VA (July 2, 2018) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Monday, July 2, 2018, due to construction and maintenance projects.

**New Projects:**

(College Drive) – A contractor will have a shoulder closure on College Drive at the Route 164 Interchange from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Porterfield Lane and Copeland Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation between Porterfield Lane and Copeland Road for shoulder maintenance from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have shoulder closures at the following locations on Bridge Road: Plummer Boulevard, Harbourview Boulevard, and College Drive from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Harbour View Boulevard) – A contractor will have shoulder closures at the following locations on Harbour View Boulevard: at Bon Secours Drive, Harbour Towne Parkway and Hampton Roads Parkway from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(College Drive) – A contractor will have alternating northbound and southbound lane closures on College Drive at University Boulevard from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Manning Bridge Road) – A contractor will have a lane closure in the 300 block of Manning Bridge Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Wilroy Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering Paint Crew will have a mobile operation on Wilroy Road between Nansemond Parkway and Progress Road from 8:30 a.m. to 1 p.m.

(Holladay Street) – A contractor will have Holladay Street closed between Finney Avenue and Central Avenue with a detour from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Copeland Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Copeland Road between Lummis Road and Manning Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Cypress Chapel Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Cypress Chapel Road, just before Carolina Road, for ditch maintenance from 12 p.m. to 3 p.m.

(Lake Prince Drive) – Suffolk Department of Public works will have a flagging operation in the 4300 block of Lake Prince Drive for ditch maintenance from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(various locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Wilroy Road, Sleepy Hole Road, Bennetts Pasture Road, Driver Lane, Freeman Mill Road and Desert Road for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 460/Pruden Boulevard) – A contractor will have mobile operations on Route 460/Pruden Boulevard between North Main Street and the Isle of Wight County line from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

**Ongoing Projects:**

(Portsmouth Boulevard) – A contractor will have a westbound right shoulder closure in the 1200 block of Portsmouth Boulevard.

(Hillpoint Road) – A contractor will have a lane closure in the 1000 block of Hillpoint Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., June 29 through July 12.

(West Constance Road) – A contractor will be installing gas lines on West Constance Road between Holland Road and Main Street. This work will take place between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. and will require periodic lane closures.

(Old Somerton Road, Carolina Road, Whaleyville Boulevard, Rosewood Drive) – A contractor will be installing new water lines on Old Somerton Road, Carolina Road, Whaleyville Boulevard, and Rosewood Drive. Work within this area will take place from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. daily and will require shoulder and/or lane closures. The speed limit within the area has been lowered to 35 mph. A southbound lane diversion will be in place between the 1300 block of Carolina Road and the 1500 block of Whaleyville Boulevard from June 26, 2018 to July 15, 2018. The project is expected to continue through September 2018.

(Oak Ridge Neighborhood) – A contractor will be installing an 8" water line in the Oak Ridge neighborhood. Work will be intermittent and require lane closures throughout the neighborhood and is expected to continue through July 2018.

(Nansemond Parkway) – The Nansemond Roadway Expansion Project continues on Nansemond Parkway between Shoulders Hill Road and the Chesapeake City line. Work in this area will require periodic eastbound and westbound shoulder and/or lane closures.

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
