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ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (July 16, 2018) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Monday, July 16, 2018, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Lakeside Street) – A contractor will have lane closure on Lakeside Street at Highland Avenue from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Highland Avenue) – A contractor will be installing services in the 300 to 400 blocks of Highland Avenue from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Bridge Road for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Shoulders Hill Road) – A contractor will have alternating lane closures on Shoulders Hill Road at Bridge Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Elizabeth Street) – A contractor will be installing services on Elizabeth Street at East Constance Road from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(various locations) – A contractor will have a concrete crew working on Nansemond Avenue, Kingsboro Street, and Lakeside Street from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(South Main Street) – A contractor will have a crew working in the 200 block of South Main Street from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Bank Street Extended) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Bank Street Extended closed between North Division Street and North Capital Street with a detour in place from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., July 16 to July 19.

(Grove Avenue) – Suffolk Department of Public Utilities will have the 200 block of Grove Avenue closed with a detour from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., July 16 and July 17.

(West Constance Road) – A contractor will have an eastbound lane shift on West Constance Road between North Broad Street and North Main Street from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Lummis Road) – A contractor will have a lane closure in the 100 block of Lummis Road from 12 p.m. to 4 p.m.

(Route 13/32 Bypass) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on the Route 13/32 Bypass for vegetation maintenance and debris pick up from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Milners Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a lane closure on Milners Road between Cherokee Court and Lake Prince Drive for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Route 58 between the Route 13/32 Bypass and Cherokee Court for debris pick up from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Route 58 between Centerpoint Drive and the Route 13/32 Bypass for pothole patching from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 460) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Route 460 between the Route 58 Interchange and Kings Fork Road for pothole patching from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(various locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on White Marsh Road, Adams Swamp Road, Rountree Crescent and Mineral Spring Road for bridge maintenance from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a mobile operation westbound on Route 58 between Holland Road and the Southampton County line for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Upcoming Projects:

(Lake Cohoon Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Operations will have the 2000 block of Lake Cohoon Road closed for bridge maintenance overnight from 6 p.m. to 6 a.m., Thursday July 19. Message boards were placed on Friday, July 13 to alert motorists of the upcoming closure.

Ongoing Projects:

(Portsmouth Boulevard) – A contractor will have a westbound right shoulder closure in the 1200 block of Portsmouth Boulevard.

(Hillpoint Road) – A contractor will have a lane closure in the 1000 block of Hillpoint Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. through July 20.

(West Constance Road) – A contractor will be installing gas lines on West Constance Road between Holland Road and Main Street. This work will take place between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. and will require periodic lane closures.

(Old Somerton Road, Carolina Road, Whaleyville Boulevard, Rosewood Drive) – A contractor will be installing new water lines on Old Somerton Road, Carolina Road, Whaleyville Boulevard, and Rosewood Drive. Work within this area will take place from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. daily and will require shoulder and/or lane closures. The speed limit within the area has been lowered to 35 mph. A southbound lane diversion will be in place between the 1300 block of Carolina Road and the 1500 block of Whaleyville Boulevard from June 26, 2018 to July 31, 2018. The project is expected to continue through September 2018.

(Oak Ridge Neighborhood) – A contractor will be installing an 8" water line in the Oak Ridge neighborhood. Work will be intermittent and require lane closures throughout the neighborhood and is expected to continue through July 2018.

(Nansemond Parkway) – The Nansemond Roadway Expansion Project continues on Nansemond Parkway between Shoulders Hill Road and the Chesapeake City line. Work in this area will require periodic eastbound and westbound shoulder and/or lane closures.

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
