(Hillpoint Road) -- A contractor will have a lane closure in the 1000 block of Hillpoint Road from 1 p.m. to 4 p.m. Work will continue in this area through Friday between the hours of 9 a.m. and 4 p.m.

ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (July 31, 2018) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Tuesday, July 31, 2018, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(Western Avenue) – A contractor will have Western Avenue closed to thru traffic between West Constance Road and Church Street from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. daily through July 31.

(College Drive) – A contractor will be working in the shoulder on College Drive at University Boulevard and at the Kroger entrance from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Burning Tree Lane, Chelsea Mews, Dockside Crescent) – A contractor will have mobile operations on Burning Tree lane, Chelsea Mews, and Dockside Crescent for a milling operation from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Longstreet Lane and Butler Drive) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 3500 block of Longstreet lane from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m. and the 3800 block of Butler Drive from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Bank Street Extended) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Bank Street Extended closed between North Lloyd Street and North Capital Street with a detour in place from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(North Main Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a northbound right lane closure in the 1900 block of North Main Street for drainage maintenance from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.

(Indian Trail) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Indian Trail at Deer Path Road for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Bob White Lane) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Bob White Lane between Shoulders Hill Road and Hawks Nest Lane from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(various locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations in the 1900 block of Cherry Grove Road, 1200 block of Greenway Road, 200 block of Freeman Mill Rod, 5500 block of Mineral Springs Road, and the 4400 block of Quaker Drive for beaver dam maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(various locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Bennetts Pasture Road, Sleepy Hole Road, Driver Lane, Horton Drive, Dutch Road, and Airport Road for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Ruritan Boulevard) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a shoulder closure in the 6700 block of Ruritan Boulevard for sidewalk repair from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(North Lloyd Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation in the 100 block of North Lloyd Street from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a mobile operation eastbound on Route 58 between Route 460 and the Chesapeake City line from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Ongoing Projects:

(Portsmouth Boulevard) – A contractor will have a westbound right shoulder closure in the 1200 block of Portsmouth Boulevard.

(West Constance Road) – A contractor will be installing gas lines on West Constance Road between Holland Road and Main Street. This work will take place between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. and will require periodic lane closures.

(Old Somerton Road, Carolina Road, Whaleyville Boulevard, Rosewood Drive) – A contractor will be installing new water lines on Old Somerton Road, Carolina Road, Whaleyville Boulevard, and Rosewood Drive. Work within this area will take place from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. daily and will require shoulder and/or lane closures. The speed limit within the area has been lowered to 35 mph. A southbound lane diversion will be in place between the 1300 block of Carolina Road and the 1500 block of Whaleyville Boulevard from June 26, 2018 to July 31, 2018. The project is expected to continue through September 2018.

(Oak Ridge Neighborhood) – A contractor will be installing an 8" water line in the Oak Ridge neighborhood. Work will be intermittent and require lane closures throughout the neighborhood and is expected to continue through July 2018.

(Nansemond Parkway) – The Nansemond Roadway Expansion Project continues on Nansemond Parkway between Shoulders Hill Road and the Chesapeake City line. Work in this area will require periodic eastbound and westbound shoulder and/or lane closures. Beginning, Friday, July 27, two westbound lane and one eastbound lane will be open to traffic.

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
