### **POLICE SEEK PUBLIC'S ASSISTANCE IDENTIFYING BUSINESS BREAKING AND ENTERING SUBJECTS**

SUFFOLK, VA (August 10, 2018) Suffolk Police are asking for the public's assistance in identifying several subjects related to a business breaking and entering incident that occurred during the early morning hours of Friday, August 10, 2018.

Officers responded to the location of Duke Automotive, located in the 2000 block of North Main Street, at approximately 3:02 a.m. in reference to an alarm call. Upon preliminary investigation it was determined that unknown subject(s) threw a brick into the front glass window and gained entry into the business.
