ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (August 23, 2018) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Thursday, August 23, 2018, due to construction and maintenance projects.

New Projects:

(South Division Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation in the 300 block of South Division Street from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Bank Street Extended) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have Bank Street Extended closed between North Lloyd Street and North 4th Street from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(North Capital Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have the 100-200 block of North Capital Street closed from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(North Lloyd Street) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 200 block of North Lloyd Street from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Copeland Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Copeland Road between Lummis Road and Manning Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Portsmouth Boulevard) – A contractor will have a westbound right lane closure in the 1200 block of Portsmouth Boulevard for a concrete curb installation from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Bennetts Pasture Road, Cherry Blossom Road, Equinox Landing and Kennett Drive) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Bennetts Pasture Road, Cherry Blossom Road, Equinox Landing and Kennett Drive for pothole patching from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 13/32 Bypass) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on the Route 13/32 Bypass for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

(Carolina Road) – A contractor will have a northbound right lane closure on the bridge at North Main Street for guardrail repair from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a westbound right shoulder closure on Route 58 just beyond the Route 460 overpass for guardrail repair from 1 p.m. to 2 p.m.

(Turlington Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation on Turlington Road at the Route 13/32 Bypass for guardrail repair from 2 p.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a westbound mobile operation on Route 58 between the Route 13/32 Bypass and the Southampton County line for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

(Gays Row) – A contractor will have Gays Row at Constance Road closed for utility marking from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Cedar Street) – A contractor will be working in the 300 block of Cedar Street from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. No traffic control needed.

(Adam Street) – A contractor will be working in the 700 block of Adam Street from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. No traffic control needed.

(Kenyon Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 100 block of Kenyon Road from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Bridge Road) – A contractor will have right turn lane closure then moving to a northbound right lane closure on Bridge Road at Knotts Neck from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a crew eastbound on Route 58 between Route 10 and Wilroy Road for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. No traffic control needed.

(North Main Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Utilities Line Maintenance Division will have a lane closure in the 700 block of North Main Street. The southbound right lane will be closed to traffic for approximately one hour (9:00am - 10:00am). Traffic will be directed to merge over to the southbound passing lane until the cleaning is complete.

(Providence Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering's paint crew will have mobile lane closures on Providence Road between Pruden Boulevard and Kings Fork Road from 12:30 p.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 10) – A contractor will have a right lane closure on Godwin Boulevard between Holly Hill Lane and Sack Point Road for a bridge inspection from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(More)

(Quaker Drive) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation on Quaker Drive between Longstreet Lane and Vicksburg Road for shoulder maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Manning Road, Wedgewood Drive, Indian Trail, Carr Lane, Barnes Road, Kingsale Road and Murphys Mill Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Manning Road, Wedgewood Drive, Indian Trail, Carr Lane, Barnes Road, Kingsale Road and Murphys Mill Road for vegetation maintenance from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Upcoming Projects:

(North Main Street – A contractor will be performing utility work in the northbound lanes in the 200 block of North Main Street requiring a traffic detour beginning at 7 p.m., Friday, August 24 until the work is complete in the evening on Saturday, August 25. As a result, it will be necessary to detour the northbound North Main Street traffic around the work site for a portion of the weekend. The northbound traffic would detour at Bank Street to Pinner Street to Finney Avenue back to North Main Street. Southbound traffic on North Main Street will not be impacted.

Ongoing Projects:

(Simons Drive) – A contractor will have Simons Drive closed to thru traffic between Indian Trail and Old Myrtle Road from August 9, 2018 to April 2, 2019 for a bridge replacement. The current bridge will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure.

(More)

(Lee Farm Lane) – A contractor will have Lee Farm Lane closed at the intersection of Bennetts Pasture Road for intersection upgrades related to The Retreat at Bennetts Creek Project, August 7 through September 4. A detour for eastbound traffic along Bennetts Pasture Road will be installed to direct traffic to Route 17. Traffic turning onto Lee Farm Lane from northbound Route 17 will be detoured around the intersection via Eberwine Lane. Periodic changes to the work will be expected.

(Portsmouth Boulevard) – A contractor will have a westbound right shoulder closure in the 1200 block of Portsmouth Boulevard.

(West Constance Road) – A contractor will be installing gas lines on West Constance Road between Holland Road and Main Street. This work will take place between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. and will require periodic lane closures.

(Kilby Lane) – A contractor working for Suffolk Department of Public Utilities will be installing a water main on Kilby Lane. The installation will require lane closures and is expected to be complete August 31.

(Old Somerton Road, Carolina Road, Whaleyville Boulevard, Rosewood Drive) – A contractor will be installing new water lines on Old Somerton Road, Carolina Road, Whaleyville Boulevard, and Rosewood Drive. Work within this area will take place from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. daily and will require shoulder and/or lane closures. The speed limit within the area has been lowered to 35 mph. Beginning Thursday, August 16, the contractor will have a southbound flagging operation in the 1500 block of Whaleyville Boulevard continuing southbound to the 1800 block daily from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. The project is expected to continue through September 2018.

(Oak Ridge Neighborhood) – A contractor will be installing an 8" water line in the Oak Ridge neighborhood. Work will be intermittent and require lane closures throughout the neighborhood.

(More)

(Nansemond Parkway) – The Nansemond Roadway Expansion Project continues on Nansemond Parkway between Shoulders Hill Road and the Chesapeake City line. Work in this area will require periodic eastbound and westbound shoulder and/or lane closures. Beginning, Friday, July 27, two westbound lanes and one eastbound lane will be open to traffic.
