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### **ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS**

SUFFOLK, VA (November 8, 2018) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures that could cause delays, Thursday, November 8, 2018, due to construction and maintenance projects.

#### **New Projects:**

(South Division Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagging operation in the 300 block of South Division Street from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Kingsboro Street) – A contractor will be working on Kingsboro Street at East Constance Road from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

(Nansemond Parkway) – Beginning Monday, November 5, a contractor will have a flagging operation in the 4800 block of Nansemond Parkway, between John C. Holland and Hargrove Landing, daily from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. The project will include work on Saturday and Sunday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. and is expected to be completed by November 30, weather permitting.

(College Drive) – A contractor will have alternating lane closures on College Drive at the Western Freeway eastbound on ramp from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(various locations) – On November 7 and November 8, a contractor will have the intersection of Western Avenue and Church Street closed with a detour in place from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. The following locations will be closed to thru traffic: Western Avenue between West Constance Road and Church Street, Western Avenue between Main Street and Church Street, Church Street between West Constance Road and Western Avenue, and Church Street between Mahan Street and Western Avenue.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have a mobile operation eastbound on Route 58 between the Route 13/32 Bypass and Chesapeake City line for vegetation maintenance in the medians from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

(Nansemond Parkway) – A contractor will have a mobile operation westbound on Nansemond Parkway between Wilroy Road and Portsmouth Boulevard from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

(Pughsville Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 3900 block of Pughsville Road from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(various locations) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have mobile operations on Cherokee Drive, Old Myrtle Road and the 4700 block of Old Mill Road for pothole patching from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 58) – A contractor will have mobile lane closures on Route 58 eastbound between Route 10 and the bridge over Nansemond Parkway from 11:30 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Route 58) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering Paint Crew will have mobile lane closures on eastbound Route 58 and westbound between Manning Bridge Road and Raleigh Drive from 11:30 a.m. to 2 p.m.

(Washington Street) – Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering Paint Crew will have mobile lane closures on Washington Street between Commerce Street and North Street from 5 p.m. to 8 p.m.

(Kings Highway) – A contractor will have a mobile operation on Kings Highway between Driver and the dead end for vegetation maintenance from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

(Manning Bridge Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a lane closure in the 300 block of Manning Bridge Road from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.

(Lake Prince Drive) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Lake Prince Drive for side cutting from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Jackson Road) – Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a mobile operation on Jackson Road for side cutting from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

(Harbour View Boulevard) – A contractor will have alternating lane closures on Harbour View Boulevard at Bon Secours Drive from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(College Drive) – A contractor will have alternating lane closures on College Drive at Lakeview Parkway from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

(East Washington Street) – A contractor will have the 200 block of East Washington Street closed with a detour in place overnight from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.

(Cherry Grove Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 1300 block of Cherry Grove Road from 8 a.m. to 11 a.m.

(Greenway Road) – A contractor will have a flagging operation in the 2000 block of Greenway Road from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m.

**Upcoming Projects:**

(Rountree Crescent) – A contractor will have a paving operation in the 200 block of Rountree Crescent from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., November 9 through November 11.

**Ongoing Projects:**

(Route 58) – A contractor will have alternating lane closures westbound on Route 58 between Wilroy Road and Route 13/32 Bypass for paving overnight from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.

(Carolina Road) – A contractor will have a detour in place for southbound traffic on Carolina Road, beginning at the intersection with Whaleyville Boulevard detouring onto Copeland Road and back onto Carolina Road daily from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. until approximately November 30, 2018. Northbound traffic on Carolina Road will not be affected. This detour will continue daily from 7 A.M. to 4 P.M. until around November 30, 2018. There will also be occasional flagging operations in the 1500 block of Whaleyville Boulevard and, during these times, the detour on Carolina Road will not be in place.

(Simons Drive) – A contractor will have Simons Drive closed to thru traffic between Indian Trail and Old Myrtle Road from August 9, 2018 to April 2, 2019 for a bridge replacement. The current bridge will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure.

(Southwestern Boulevard) – Southwestern Boulevard will be closed between OKelly Drive and Trumpet Drive with a detour in place from November 2, 2018 to April 2019 for a bridge replacement. The current bridge will be removed and replaced with a concrete structure.

(Portsmouth Boulevard) – A contractor will have the eastbound and westbound shoulders closed in the 1200 block of Portsmouth Boulevard.

(West Washington Street) – A contractor will have a westbound right lane closure in the 1000 block of West Washington Street between Lipton Tea and the bridge from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. daily.

(Old Somerton Road, Carolina Road, Whaleyville Boulevard, Rosewood Drive) – A contractor will be installing new water lines on Old Somerton Road, Carolina Road, Whaleyville Boulevard, and Rosewood Drive. The speed limit within the area has been lowered to 35 mph. Beginning Thursday, August 16, the contractor will have a southbound flagging operation and occasional northbound lane closures in the 1500 block of Whaleyville Boulevard continuing southbound to the 1800 block daily from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. The project is expected to continue through December 2018.

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
