CITY OFFICES THANKSGIVING HOLIDAY CLOSING SCHEDULE

SUFFOLK, VA (November 14, 2018) In observance of Thanksgiving, City of Suffolk offices will close at 12 p.m., Wednesday, November 21, 2018 and remain closed Thursday, November 22nd and Friday, November 23rd. Normal operations will resume Monday, November 26, 2018, at 8:30 a.m. The City observes all state-designated holidays. Thanksgiving is considered a holiday for the Commonwealth of Virginia, and all state offices are closed on these days.

Trash scheduled for pickup on Thursday, November 22nd, will be collected on Friday, November 23rd. Trash scheduled for pickup on Friday, November 23rd, will be collected on Saturday, November 24th. TFC Recycling will also follow the holiday schedule with the Thursday, November 22nd recycling routes being collected on Friday, November 23rd and the Friday, November 23rd recycling routes being collected on Saturday, November 24th. **Suffolk Public Works Department** reminds you that trash must be placed at curbside no later than 7 a.m. on the day of collection. **Businesses located in the Downtown Business Overlay District (DBOD) will have their collection day run on the regular schedule on Friday.** For more information on refuse collection, please call Public Works at 514-7630.

The **Southeastern Public Service Authority (SPSA) Transfer Station in Suffolk** will be closed Thursday, November 22nd and will be open from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m. on Friday, November 23rd and 8 a.m. to 12 p.m. on Saturday, November 24th. The **Regional Landfill** is closed on Thursday, November 22nd, and will be open from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m. on Friday, November 23rd and 8 a.m. to 12 p.m. on Saturday, November 24th.

Suffolk Transit will not be in operation on Thursday, November 22nd due to the holiday. Suffolk Transit will run as scheduled on Wednesday, November 21st, Friday, November 23rd, and Saturday, November 24th.

Suffolk Parks & Recreation Joint Use Recreation Centers (Kings Fork, Creekside, Northern Shores, Oakland, Booker T. Washington, Mack Benn, Jr.) will close at 6 p.m. on Wednesday, November 21st and will remain closed Thursday, November 22nd and Friday, November 23rd. The **East Suffolk Recreation Center** and the **Whaleyville Community Center** will close at 12 p.m. on Wednesday, November 21st and will remain closed Thursday, November 22nd and Friday, November 23rd. The East Suffolk Recreation Center and the Whaleyville Community Center will be open on Saturday, November 24th from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m. The **Suffolk Parks & Recreation Administration Office** will close at 12 p.m. on Wednesday, November 21st and will reopen on Monday, November 26th.

Suffolk's four major parks (Lone Star Lakes, Constant's Wharf, Sleepy Hole, Bennett's Creek) will remain open during the holiday. However, no park attendant will be on duty Thursday, November 22nd and Friday, November 23rd.

All **Suffolk City Libraries (Morgan Memorial, North Suffolk, Chuckatuck)** close at 12 p.m. on Wednesday, November 21st and will remain closed November 22nd through November 24th. All Library Branches reopen at their regular operating hours on Monday, November 26th.

The **Suffolk Art Gallery** will close at 12 p.m., Wednesday, November 21st, and will remain closed Thursday, November 22nd through Monday, November 26th. The Suffolk Art Gallery will reopen on Tuesday, November 27th.

The **Suffolk Tourism Visitor Center** and **Suffolk Seaboard Station Railroad Museum** will be closed Thursday, November 22nd and Friday, November 23rd for the Thanksgiving Holiday.

The **Suffolk Executive Airport Terminal** will be closed on Thursday, November 22nd. The terminal will remain open but will be unmanned on Friday, November 23rd. The airfield will remain open with self-service fuel available. The on-site restaurant will be open for regular business hours.
