DETACHED GARAGE DAMAGED IN FIRE

SUFFOLK, Virginia (November 25, 2018) Suffolk Fire & Rescue units responded earlier this evening, Sunday, November 25, 2018, to a residential structure fire in rural Suffolk.

Emergency Communications was notified at 6:45 p.m. and the first units arrived on scene in the 1700 block of Cotton Farm Lane at 6:52 p.m.

Captain B. Sweat advised that upon arrival heavy fire was showing from the two-story detached garage. There was no fire exposure to the primary residence. Firefighters were able to quickly knock down the fire which was called under control at 7:27 p.m. The garage, approximately 2200 square feet, was declared a partial loss.

There were no injuries. Suffolk Police provided traffic control at the scene.

Responding units included Engines 5 and 29, Ladders 5 and 6. Tankers 1 and 9, Battalions 1 and 2, Rescue 1, Safety 1, and EMS-1. The Fire Marshal's Office will be handling the investigation as to the cause of the fire.
