POLICE SEEK PUBLIC'S ASSISTANCE IN LOCATING MISSING ENDANGERED ADULT

SUFFOLK, VA (January 16, 2019) - The Suffolk Police Department is seeking the public's assistance in locating a missing endangered adult.

Orin Barrymore Teasley, age 49, a Suffolk resident, was last seen in the area of Maryview Hospital in Portsmouth, Virginia, on January 8, 2019. He was reported as missing on January 11, 2019, and was declared as endangered this evening in light of additional information provided. Mr. Teasley is further described as a black male who is 6'1" tall and weighs approximately 220 pounds. He has black hair and brown eyes. Mr. Teasley has a diminished mental capacity and has been reported to need continuous care with day-to-day functions and may not know his surroundings or address, therefore making him endangered.
